 Authorize the Purchasing Agent, in accordance with Ordinance 459.4, to issue a sole source Purchase Order to Envisionware, Inc. and to renew the maintenance services for the system annually for up to two additional one year periods, provided the cost increase does not exceed the Consumer Price Index.

#### BACKGROUND:

Riverside County Library System is in need of an automated materials handling (AMH) sorter and radio frequency identification (RFID) hardware and software solution for the Palm Desert Library that will secure materials and allow for customer self-service, materials check-out, and automated materials check-in. AMH and RFID allow for re-direction of staff labor by lowering the costs of materials acquisition, reducing materials losses, collecting fines, encouraging patron self-sufficiency through self-checkout kiosks, thereby freeing up staff to assist patrons with their educational, informational, and learning resource needs.

EnvisionWare, Inc. equipment and software is geared toward larger libraries with high volumes of circulation. It was the only company with both the proven capacity to design a system to operate efficiently within the unique needs of Palm Desert Library including a book sorter capable of managing eight bins with workroom access for staff and secure access points inside and outside the library for patrons, for example. Since EnvisionWare was present at Palm Desert before the remodel project, it is able to provide equipment and software that is familiar to both staff and patrons thereby lowering the learning curve for library staff which will in turn free staff to spend more time addressing patrons' information needs.

Envisionware, Inc. is unique in that they can provide the equipment and software required at a very competitive price for the Palm Desert Library, which typically has the highest level of materials circulation in the library system. Envisionware, Inc. will also provide Riverside County Library System with an RFID and Self-Service Circulation Software Site License. It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve the Sole Source Agreement (Exhibit A).

#### **FINANCIAL DATA:**

Sufficient funds to cover all costs associated with the purchase of the AMH sorter and RFID system have been budgeted in the FY2012-2013 County Free Library budget. Future fiscal year budgets will include funds to cover the annual maintenance fee.

Sole Source Procurement: Request for EnvisionWare

The information below is provided in support of my Department requesting approval for a sole source. Outside of a duly declared emergency, the time to develop a statement of work or specifications is not in itself justification for sole source.

- 1. Supply/Service being requested: Automated Materials Handling System (AMHS) or "book sorter"; RFID accessories; all inclusive site and system software licenses; self-checkout kiosks hardware and software; security gates; on-site installation and training; annual maintenance agreements. Original copies of Supplier Quotations are attached here.
- 2. Supplier being requested: EnvisionWare© (www.envisionware.com)
- 3. Alternative suppliers that can or might be able to provide supply/service: None who meet the unique physical and financial requirements for the space allocated for the Palm Desert Library project. EnvisionWare was utilized in the Palm Desert Library before the remodeling project and is able to provide consistency in addressing the software and equipment needs which are extremely important in reducing the staff learning curve as well as redirecting staff assistance to patron's information needs. Staff reductions and re-assignments make it necessary to increase patron selfsufficiency for activities like checking out books and paying fines made possible through self-check kiosks. Palm Desert typically has the highest volume of materials circulation in the library system frequently circulating 70,000 to nearly 85,000 books per month. EnvisionWare equipment and software is geared towards larger libraries with high volumes of circulation. It was the only company with both the proven capacity to design a system to operate efficiently within the unique needs of Palm Desert Library —including a book sorter capable of managing eight bins with workroom access for staff and secure access points inside and outside the library for patrons, security gates with people counters to handle accurately multiple entries and exits from the library, multiple self-check kiosks so that patrons can check out their own books and pay fines without staff assistance, multiple staff computer workstations for RFID tagging anywhere in the library that can double as public access catalog stations and with supporting RFID software for which the Supplier EnvisionWare supplies several other library sites. As a result, the existing site license will incorporate Palm Desert library at no extra cost to the County.
- 4. Extent of market search conducted: Library staff reviewed other suppliers for equipment and software and evaluated them for ability to meet the unique demands for handling high volumes of materials which can total nearly 80,000 items per month and the physical limitations of the space allocated for library technology at Palm Desert, including supplying the book sorter equipment (tracks and at least eight bins which indicate when the bin is full) and security gates that would fit into the space, the discounted pricing for multiple site software licenses, RFID tags and tagging work stations while at the same time meeting the budget allocations for the project and providing training and a maintenance agreement. EnvisionWare was utilized in the Palm Desert Library before the remodeling project and is able to provide consistency in addressing the software and equipment needs which are extremely important in reducing the staff learning curve as well as redirecting staff assistance to the patron's information needs. The market for these kinds of services is limited and highly competitive. But given the limitations, EnvisionWare was most qualified for delivering right-

sized equipment including software and hardware while at the same time meeting the budget limitations of the project.

- 5. Unique features of the supply/service being requested from this supplier, which no alternative supplier can provide: EnvisionWare equipment and software is geared towards larger libraries with high volumes of circulation. Palm Desert typically has the highest volume of materials circulation in the library system frequently circulating 70,000 to nearly 85,000 books per month. Further, EnvisionWare was utilized in the Palm Desert Library before the remodeling project and is able to provide consistency in addressing the software and equipment training needs which are extremely important in reducing the staff learning curve as well as redirecting staff assistance to patron's information needs. Staff reductions and re-assignments make it necessary to increase patron self-sufficiency for activities like checking out books and paying fines made possible through public access catalogs and self-check kiosks which will be supplied by EnvisionWare.
- 6. Reasons why my department requires these unique features and what benefit will accrue to the county: The County Library has a critical role in economic development because it supplies free information to its communities. Located on the College of the Desert campus, Palm Desert Library circulates on average nearly 80,000 books and other items per month and typically has the highest volume of materials circulation in the library system. EnvisionWare equipment and software is geared towards larger libraries with high volumes of circulation. It was the only company with both the proven capacity to design a system to operate efficiently within the unique needs of Palm Desert Library —including a book sorter capable of managing eight bins with workroom access for staff and secure access points inside and outside the library for patrons for example. Since EnvisionWare was utilized at Palm Desert before the remodel project, it is able to provide equipment and software that is familiar to both staff and patrons thereby lowering the learning curve for library staff which will in turn free staff to spend more time addressing patrons' information needs. Especially in the current economic climate where staff layoffs or reductions have become common, the unique features offered by EnvisionWare in its AMHS and RFID hardware and software lower the costs of materials acquisition, reduce materials losses, collect fines, encourage patron self-sufficiency and save time and thereby freeing up staff more often to work directly with patrons to help them with their educational, informational and learning resource needs. This state-of-the-art technology also demonstrates the County's high value of and investment in its communities.
- 7. Price Reasonableness including purchase price and any ongoing maintenance or ancillary costs from the supplier: Envisionware was the most competitive because its equipment is geared towards larger libraries with high volumes of circulation. It was the only company with both the proven capacity to design a system to operate efficiently within the unique needs of Palm Desert Library including a book sorter capable of managing eight bins with workroom access for staff and secure access points inside and outside the library for patrons for example. With EnvisionWare we recognize economies of scale for site licenses for the software and hardware which can be considerable since one site license will cover approximately 10 other libraries in addition to Palm Desert.
- 8. Does moving forward on this product or service further obligate the county to future similar contractual arrangements or any ongoing costs affiliated with this sole source? (Maintenance, support, or upgrades, if so, please explain). Service agreements which limit servicing operations to the supplier are standard for the industry. EnvisionWare provided RFID or RFID and sorter combinations to multiple sites in the library system including a maintenance agreement which will cover all of the sites.
