BACKGROUND: On March 27, 2012 the Board of Supervisors approved acceptance of a funding award from the California Corrections Standards Authority for funds to plan and construct the new East County Detention Center, to be constructed on the site of the current County Administrative Center in the City of Indio. The Public Defender currently has staff occupying space at the Indio CAC and will need to relocate in order for construction to commence on the new project.
