BACKGROUND (Continued)

On August 21, 2012 the Department of Public Health received ATS 005 releasing \$635,000 in additional funds for WIC replacement equipment. The funds are allocated for replacement equipment to meet WIC business needs at all 19 WIC sites throughout the county.

Currently eleven of the 19 WIC sites do not have their own server, causing slower performance and security issues. RCIT has approved the purchase (#24820) of eleven (11) HP ProLiant ML350e Gen8 Servers at a unit cost of \$20,105. The servers will provide needed file storage, improved security and increase efficiency of data processing. RCIT has also approved the purchase (#24819) of 180 replacement computer systems at a total cost of \$245,468 to replaced aged neoware that no longer meet county IT standards for security. The remaining funds will be used for IT labor to install equipment as well as other communication devices/software necessary to improve the security and efficiency for state WIC ISIS connectivity.
