## **BACKGROUND** (continued):

The Agreement is necessary to formalize the transfer of necessary rights of way and to provide for District construction inspection of the referenced drainage facilities. Upon completion of the facilities' construction, the District will assume ownership, operation and maintenance of the mainline storm drain facilities. County will assume ownership and maintenance of the associated catch basins, lateral storm drain facilities, and connector pipes located within their right of way.

County Counsel has approved the Agreement as to legal form and the County and the Developer have executed the Agreement. A companion item appears on the Riverside County Transportation Department's agenda this same date.

### FINANCIAL:

The Developer is funding all construction and construction inspection costs. Future operation and maintenance costs associated with the mainline facilities will accrue to the District.
