2) Authorize and direct the Auditor-Controller to issue a warrant to the State of California, Board of Equalization in the amount of \$50,292.50, no sooner than ninety days from the date of this order, unless pursuant to the California Revenue and Taxation Code Section 4675, an appeal has been filed in Superior Court.

### **BACKGROUND:** (Continued)

In accordance with Section 3691 et seq. of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, and with prior approval of the Board of Supervisors, the Tax Collector conducted the March 17, 2008 public auction sale. The deed conveying title to the purchasers at the auction was recorded May 12, 2008. Further, as required by Section 4676 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, notice of the right to claim excess proceeds was given on June 9, 2008, to parties of interest as defined in Section 4675 of said code. Parties of interest have been determined by an examination of lot book reports as well as Assessor's and Recorder's records, and various research methods were used to obtain current mailing addresses for these parties of interest.

The Treasurer-Tax Collector has received one claim for excess proceeds:

1) Claim from the State of California, Board of Equalization based on a Notice of State Tax Lien recorded July 5, 2001 as Instrument No. 2001-308938 and a Notice of State Tax Lien recorded August 19, 2002 as Instrument No. 2002-457827.

Pursuant to Section 4675 (a) & (e) of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, it is the recommendation of this office that the State of California, Board of Equalization be awarded excess proceeds in the amount of \$50,292.50. Supporting documentation has been provided. The Tax Collector requests approval of the above recommended motion.
