BACKGROUND: On November 6, 1990, a majority of voters in Riverside County voted to form the Riverside County Regional Park & Open-Space District (District). In that same measure, pursuant to Article XIII B of the California Constitution, the District's appropriations limit was set at \$25,000,000. Section 7910 of the Government Code requires that each year the governing body of each local jurisdiction adopt a resolution to establish its appropriations limit for the following fiscal year.

WHEREAS Proposition 111 as approved by the voters of the State of California, requires a recorded vote of the Board of Directors regarding which of the annual adjustment factors have been selected each year; and

WHEREAS Section 7902(b) of the Government Code sets forth the method for determining the appropriations limit for each local jurisdiction for the 2012-2013 fiscal year; and WHEREAS the Board of Directors of the RIVERSIDE COUNTY REGIONAL PARK AND OPEN-SPACE DISTRICT wishes to establish the appropriations limit for fiscal year 2012-2013 for the RIVERSIDE COUNTY REGIONAL PARK AND OPEN-SPACE DISTRICT.
