SUBJECT: Ratify the acceptance of the Grant Agreement from PetSmart Charities, Inc. to the Department of Animal Services for spay/neuter surgeries, vaccinations and microchips

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BACKGROUND (Continued):

The Department's focus will be altering, vaccinating and microchipping 700 dogs, representing 50% of the estimated low income dog population, within an identified high concern group of census blocks in the City of Jurupa Valley within two years. The program will be implemented using door-to-door community outreach, a highly publicized dog licensing amnesty program, spay/neuter, and other services offered for free through our Western Riverside Shelter clinic, located in the City of Jurupa Valley. Progress will be tracked by collecting data on the number of licensed/altered dogs in the community.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The department budgets the grant funding accordingly in their department budget. No additional County funds are required.


