SUBJECT: Acceptance of funding and approval of the amendment with RCCD to establish a Physician Assistant Mental Health Fellowship Program

BACKGROUND:

The RCCD and RCRMC Family Practice Physicians have established an integrated physician assistant training program to ensure physician assistant students receive an appropriate wide variety of clinical experiences to assure physician assistant students are fully trained. In an effort to continue to meet the needs for the RCCD Physician Assistant training program, RCCD and RCRMC have agreed to continue to provide clinical training and experience in Psychiatry health care services to the graduate physician assistants enrolled in the RCCD mental health fellowship program.

This fellowship program will provide on-site education and training to a maximum of three (3) graduate physician assistants, per fellowship rotation, for the care of patients in the clinical field of psychiatry. RCRMC will continue to meet with RCCD to develop and operate the program incorporating the principles of the Medical Health Services Act.

6. Enrollees will be provided a monthly stipend of four thousand five hundred dollars (\$4,500) payable no later than the 5th working day of each month.

FUNDING PROVISIONS:

Maximum reimbursable amount for the Mental Health Fellowship Program is ninety-nine thousand, eight hundred eight dollars (\$99,808) as awarded to RCCD by the Song-Brown Health Care Workforce Training Act payable to COUNTY upon execution of this Agreement.

Quarterly financial reports outlining expenditures will be provided to RCCD within forty-five (45) calendar days after the end of the quarter.
