BACKGROUND continued:

Construction of the Sunnymead MDP Line B (Heacock Channel) Stage 3 project has long been a priority for the District, City of Moreno Valley and March Joint Powers Authority. Sunnymead Line B currently exists as an unimproved earthen ditch along the westerly side of Heacock Street. Severe erosion along the banks of the ditch has at times compromised the travelled way and threatened to undermine underground utilities. Moreover, homes and properties situated easterly of Heacock Street face the constant threat of flooding from even relatively minor storms.

The City of Moreno Valley now desires to fund (with their ADP dollars) the engineering and environmental work necessary to ready the project for construction. The project will extend from Cactus Avenue southerly approximately one and one-half miles along the eastern boundary of the March Air Reserve Base to the District's Perris Valley Lateral A Channel.

FINANCIAL:

The City of Moreno Valley is funding all design and environmental analysis work necessary for the project. The District, City of Moreno Valley and March Joint Powers Authority intend to enter into a separate agreement setting forth terms regarding the design, construction, operation and maintenance of the facility.
