**BACKGROUND:**

CAP Riverside's Project L.E.A.D. Program recruits, trains and deploys mentors/tutors to assist students enrolled in after-school programs at local middle schools in the Riverside Unified, Alvord Unified, and NuView School Districts. Project L.E.A.D. volunteers provide cross-generation mentoring/tutoring through homework assistance and character development activities such as recreation, arts and crafts, music, computers and academic coursework.

The agreement with FES provides \$17,000 for programmatic activities.
