BACKGROUND: By Minute Order dated August 28, 2012 (Agenda Item 3.101), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of Traffic Signal modifications and roadway widening at the intersection of Limonite Avenue and Etiwanda Avenue, in the City of Jurupa Valley. The specifications and plans were approved by that Board of Supervisors' action.

Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at 2:00 PM, Wednesday, September 19, 2012. Seven bids were received, ranging from \$354,450 to \$484,000. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Hillcrest Contracting, Inc. of Corona in the amount of \$354,450, which is \$63,380 (15%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

Funds were budgeted and design was underway prior to incorporation of the City of Jurupa Valley. The City of Jurupa Valley desires for the County to continue as lead agency through project completion and they have approved the construction drawings. The City of Jurupa Valley will maintain the signal after completion.

The proposed project will increase traffic capacity and improve traffic safety. In addition to the signal modification, the proposed improvements include widening of the north side of Limonite Avenue east of Etiwanda Avenue to convert an existing westbound right turn lane into a through lane, which will increase capacity and reduce delay at the intersection. Other improvements consist of a raised median on the east leg that will reduce conflicts by prohibiting left-turning movements near the intersection, sidewalk, and ADA conforming access ramps at all four corners of the intersection.

The construction of this signal project will be funded by the Development Impact Fee (DIF) program, which is governed under Ordinance 659.6 and allows for the use of DIF funds for traffic signal facilities.

The project is expected to be completed within the existing budget as shown on Attachment A.

The contractor is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, and has executed the contract and provided performance and payment bonds which meet the requirements of the contract.

13 WHEREAS, the City of Jurupa Valley during a meeting on July 3, 2012, considered the
14 Limonite and Etiwanda intersection improvement project (the "Project") as a priority, which involves
15 traffic signal modification and widening of Limonite Avenue to provide a second westbound through lane
16 on Limonite east of Etiwanda, and instructed City staff to work with the County regarding the construction
17 of this Project; and

18 WHEREAS, City staff at an August 30, 2012 meeting did confirm the City's desire to work
19 with County to move forward with Project;

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of
21 Riverside assembled in regular session on November 27, 2012 that the County hereby agrees to complete
22 the Project at an estimated full cost of Five Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-Five
23 Dollars (\$552,785), for which the City will not provide financial participation.

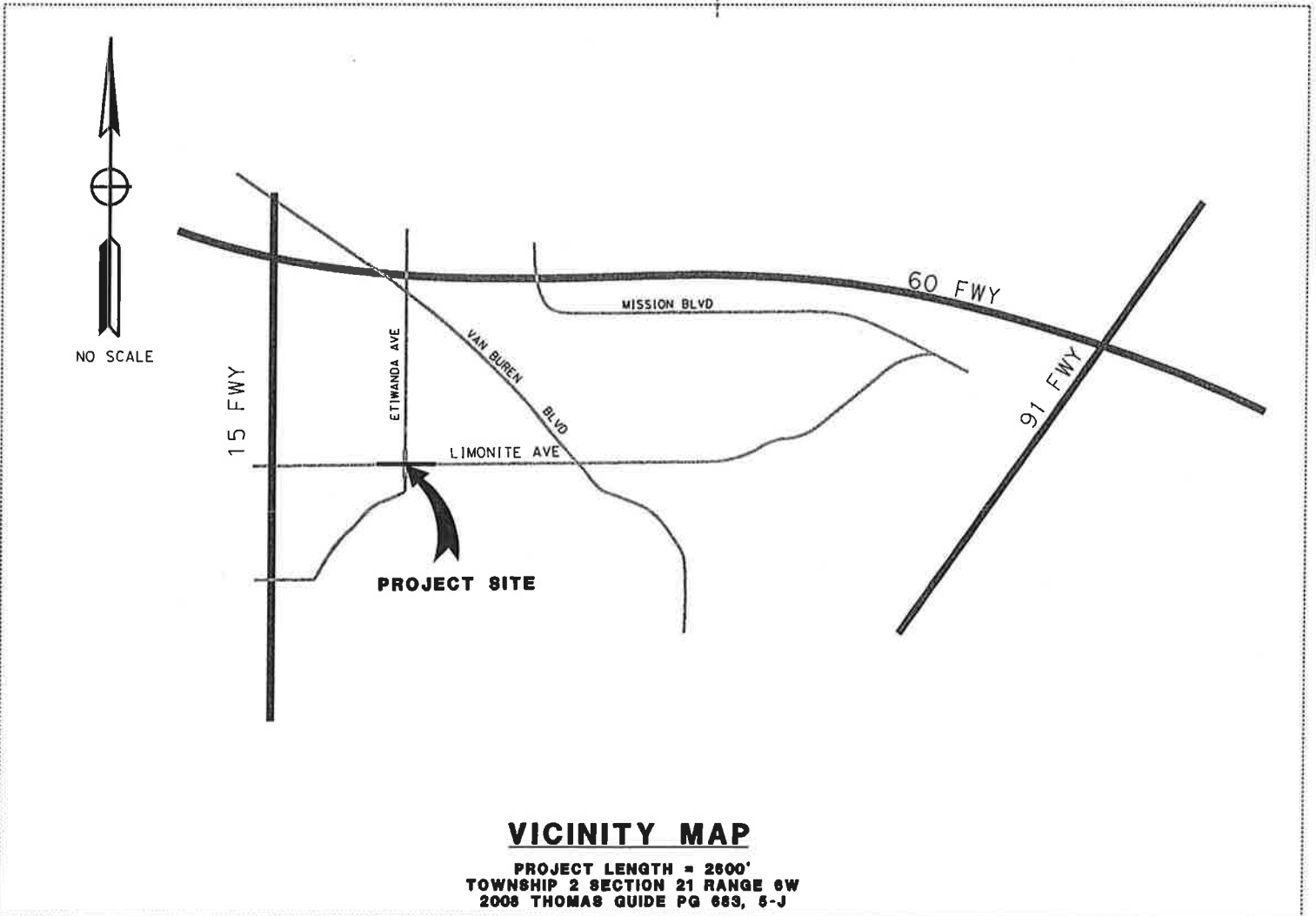
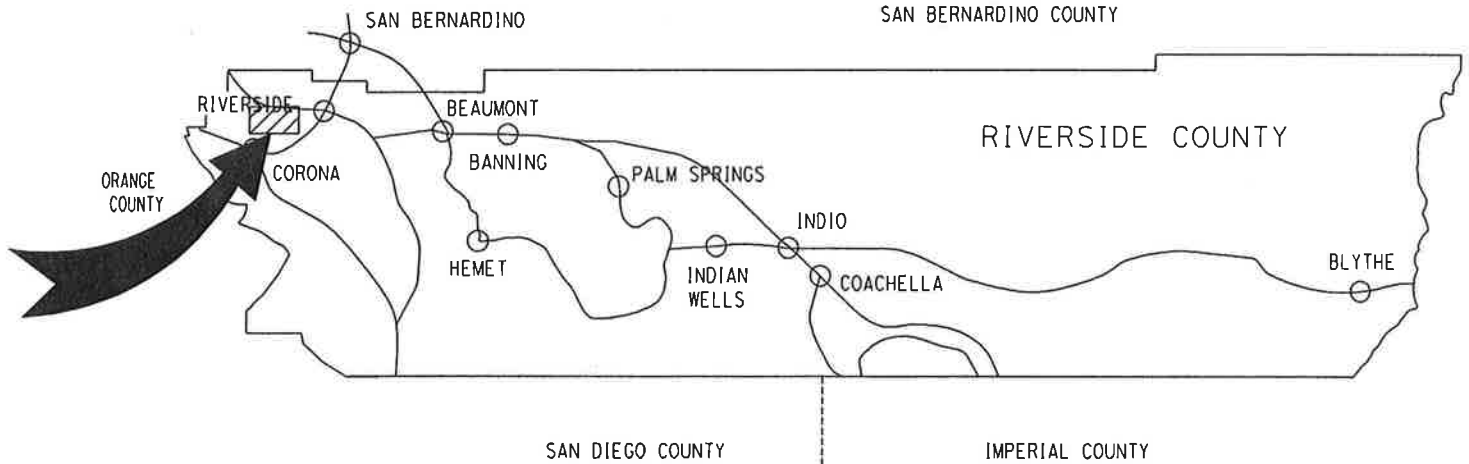

BACKGROUND CONT: Section 53608 also allows the Board to delegate to the County Treasurer the Board's authority to deposit funds for safekeeping. Under these statutes, the delegation of authority to the County Treasurer may be revoked by ordinance at any time.

In summary, Ordinance No. 767.16 renews the Board's delegation to the County Treasurer of its authority to invest or reinvest funds of the County and other depositors in the County Treasury, to sell or exchange securities, and to deposit funds for safekeeping.

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ORDINANCE NO. 767.16

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 767 DELEGATING AUTHORITY
TO THE COUNTY TREASURER TO INVEST AND REINVEST FUNDS
OF THE COUNTY AND OTHER DEPOSITORS AND TO DEPOSIT
FOR SAFEKEEPING CERTAIN INSTRUMENTS IN IDENTIFIED
FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

Section 1. Subsection a. of Section 3. of Ordinance No. 767 is amended to read as follows:

“a. The authority to invest or to reinvest funds of a local agency, or to sell or exchange securities so purchased for a period of one year from the effective date of this ordinance with such delegation expiring on December 27, 2013. The County Treasurer shall assume full responsibility for these transactions until the Board of Supervisors either revokes this delegation of authority by ordinance or until the delegation expires. The Board of Supervisors may renew this delegation of authority for subsequent one-year periods by adopting an amendment to this ordinance.”
