BACKGROUND: By Board action dated September 2, 2008, Agenda Item No. 3.151, the Board of Supervisors approved the "Reimbursement Agreement for the Construction of Jurupa Community Services District Facilities as Part of the Van Buren Bridge and Roadway Replacement Project by Riverside County" and authorized the Chairman of the Board to execute the Agreement on behalf of the County.

The executed Agreement provides for the installation of a 24-inch sewer pipeline and an 18-inch recycled water pipeline, for future use, into the new Van Buren Boulevard Bridge structure as part of the County's construction contract.

The total estimate of costs for the work under the Agreement was \$1,601,898.00. The County awarded the construction contract to the firm of Griffith Company due to the County's receipt of lower than expected bid prices.

After the project was awarded for construction, JCSD requested that the County negotiate a Construction Change Order (CCO) for the extension of the sewer pipeline beyond the original designated limits of the facilities. The County has negotiated CCO #12 with its contractor in the amount of \$431,785.54 and has received written concurrence from JCSD to approve CCO #12 and commence construction of the sewer pipeline extension. The additional work increases the JCSD costs from \$1,601,898.00 to a total of \$1,820,864.00, as shown on Exhibit "A".

All costs associated with the installation of a 24-inch sewer pipeline and an 18-inch recycled water pipeline, including the extension of a 24-Inch sewer pipeline beyond the original designated limit of work from the Van Buren Boulevard Bridge to the Jurupa Avenue sewer pipeline, will be borne by JCSD.

JCSD has executed the submitted Agreement Amendment, which has been reviewed and approved by County Counsel.

BACKGROUND: On May 19, 2009 (agenda item 3.38) the Board entered into an agreement with Griffith Company of Santa Ana, CA for the bridge replacement and the approach roadway improvements on Van Buren Boulevard at the Santa Ana River. The authorized amount of the contract was \$34,834,325.

Contract Change Order No. 8 in the amount of \$401,782.09 became necessary in order to compensate the Contractor for constructing the roadway improvements along the west side of Van Buren Boulevard between Clay Street and the new Van Buren Bridge. Contract Change Order No. 12 in the amount of \$431,785.54 became necessary in order to compensate the Contractor for constructing the JCSD sewer force extension from the new Van Buren bridge south abutment to Jurupa Avenue. This work also includes the installation of approximately 120 lineal feet of 12" Ductile Iron Pipe (DIP) at the intersection of Clay Street and Van Buren Boulevard.

The additional extra work will facilitate construction and minimize disruption to the public in the future. The change orders, in the amount of \$401,782.09 and \$431,785.54 respectively, combine for an amount of \$833,567.63 (2.4% of the original contract amount), each exceeding the Director of Transportation's approval authority under Board Resolution 2011-015.

JUSTIFICATION:

Contract Change Order No. 8 became necessary in order to construct the ultimate street improvements north of Van Buren Bridge to Clay Street in accordance with the City of Riverside/ County of Riverside Animal Shelter plans (MS4173). The proposed street improvements from Clay St. to the Van Buren bridge project limits include providing pavement widening, curb and gutter, sidewalks, catch basin, including electrical conduit and pull boxes for future street lights. This work was intended to be constructed as part of the Animal Shelter improvement project performed by the County's Economic Development Agency. These ultimate street improvements could not be performed by the Animal Shelter contractor because the improvements connected to the new and not yet constructed Van Buren Bridge alignment. This change will be funded with Measure A funds.

Contract Change Order No. 12 became necessary to construct the a new sewer force main extension through the project site in accordance with Jurupa Community Services District plans and standards. These changes were incorporated by JCSD in anticipation of the future sewer force main connection to the City of Riverside treatment plant. The inclusion of the installation of the 24" sewer force main extension and 12" DIP in conjunction with the bridge project construction protects the community's investment in the project by eliminating future construction impacts to that portion of Van Buren Blvd. There will be less impact to the public now and in the future since the construction of the Van Buren Bridge project is in progress. The amount of Contract Change Order No. 12 is funded entirely by JCSD per the attached commitment letter from JCSD.

The inclusion of additional work in this contract is a benefit to the public and surrounding communities, the Department considers that increasing the Director of Transportation's authority for cumulative change orders from 10% to 15% to take into account the financial impacts of these two change orders, is warranted and in the best interest of the public.





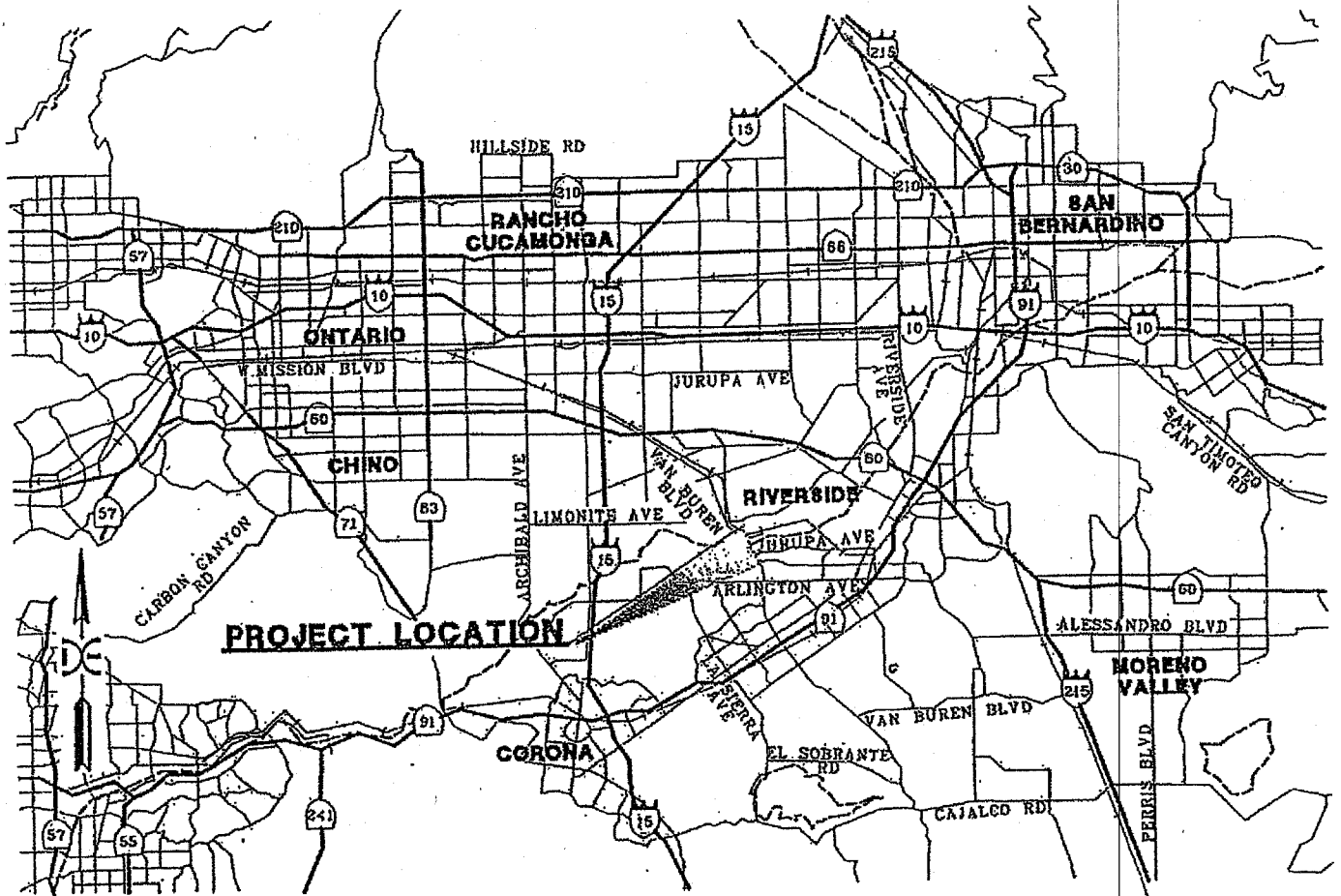

**REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION
OF JURUPA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT FACILITIES
AS PART OF THE VAN BUREN BRIDGE AND ROADWAY REPLACEMENT
PROJECT BY RIVERSIDE COUNTY**

This Reimbursement Agreement is made and entered into this 2nd day of SEP, 2008 by and between the **JURUPA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT**, a public agency (hereinafter "JCSD") and the **COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE**, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter "County").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County, acting as lead agency, is in the process of preparing public bid documents for the Van Buren Bridge and Roadway Replacement Project (hereinafter "Project"); and

WHEREAS, JCSD desires for County to include two (2) 24-Inch sewerlines and one (1) 18-inch recycled waterline (hereinafter "JCSD Facilities") in the Project at the expense of JCSD; and

WHEREAS, the County and JCSD desire this work to be performed for the benefit of the entire community by expediting installation of the sewerlines and recycled waterline piping at this time; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Agreement and the Exhibits attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein, is to set forth the financial and other arrangements between the County and JCSD for the construction of the JCSD Facilities.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the above recited premises, together with the mutual covenants herein contained and attached hereto, it is agreed that:

AGREEMENT

1. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This Agreement is intended to provide for the construction and funding of the JCSD Facilities within the Project area. A description of the JCSD Facilities, a detailed scope of work, and the estimated costs of the JCSD Facilities, are more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

2. FINANCIAL PARTICIPATION

The total estimated cost for the construction of the JCSD Facilities is \$1,601,900 (hereinafter "JCSD Construction Cost"). The County will include the JCSD Facilities as separate bid items in its bid schedule. The County shall ensure that the bid documents contain a provision which states that the selected bidder will construct the JCSD Facilities provided JCSD approves of both the County's selected bidder and the bid price for the JCSD Facilities.

In the event that changes made during construction require additional work to be performed, that additional work shall be paid by JCSD.

Improvements to JCSD Facilities, which JCSD has requested to be included in County's construction contract as described in Exhibit "A", will be constructed at the sole expense of JCSD, including design, construction, inspection, and contract administration expenses.

Upon completion of all Project work, County shall calculate all final costs incurred by the County for the construction of the JCSD Facilities and shall submit to JCSD a final statement of costs, which statement shall clearly set forth the total amount of funds paid or deposited by JCSD, and the total sum remaining due to, or from JCSD, if any. Any sum remaining unpaid shall be paid by JCSD within sixty (60) calendar days from the date of submission of final statement by County. Any amounts due to JCSD shall be paid by County within sixty (60) calendar days from date of final statement.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, JCSD shall have no obligation to pay the JCSD Construction Cost or any revised construction costs unless JCSD approves of the selected bidder and revised construction costs, as set forth more fully in section 5 herein.

3. CONSTRUCTION PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS

JCSD shall prepare detailed construction plans, specifications and cost estimates for that portion of the Project involving the JCSD Facilities. County shall utilize JCSD plans and specifications in County's Project. All costs incurred for preparation of said construction plans and specifications will be solely paid by JCSD. JCSD shall submit draft plans and specifications to County and County's design engineer for review for conformance with design of project. The County permit for JCSD will be obtained by Dokken Engineering (Design Consultant for both JCSD and County of Riverside). Any delay costs that are incurred which are attributable to the absence of encroachment permit authority to construct the facilities of JCSD will be the funding responsibility of JCSD.

4. CEQA

JCSD and County shall be jointly responsible for compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act.

5. CONSTRUCTION BIDS AND AWARD OF CONTRACT

JCSD has elected to have the JCSD Facilities constructed by the County's contractor. Upon receipt of the bids and acceptance of the lowest bid from a responsive, responsible bidder, County shall revise the JCSD Construction Cost based on the accepted bid ("Revised JCSD Construction Cost"). County shall notify JCSD of the Revised JCSD Construction Cost and request approval by JCSD, in writing, of the selected bidder and of the Revised JCSD Construction Cost for the construction of the JCSD Facility. JCSD shall notify County of its decision no later than fourteen (14) days after JCSD's receipt of the County's written request for approval. If JCSD informs County in writing that it does not approve award of JCSD Facilities, then JCSD agrees

to perform the work with its own or contract forces so as to not delay the construction schedule of County.

If JCSD approves of the selected bidder and the Revised JCSD Construction Cost, JCSD shall deposit with the County an amount equal to ninety percent (90%) of the Revised JCSD Construction Cost not later than 30 days after County's written request for approval.

6. CONSTRUCTION AND INSPECTION RESPONSIBILITIES

All JCSD Facilities furnished, constructed and installed by County's contractor shall be installed in strict compliance with JCSD's plans and specifications. All materials furnished by County's contractor must conform to JCSD's approved material list. Any and all deviations from said plans and specifications must be approved by JCSD, in writing, prior to being made. Change orders involving JCSD's Facilities shall not be implemented by County without JCSD's prior written approval. However, JCSD agrees that County's Resident Engineer, who is the County's on-site construction manager, may order additional work, in advance of receipt of written authorization from JCSD, if the County's Resident Engineer determines that additional work is urgently needed for the protection of life or property or to avoid loss of productivity that is likely to result in a delay claim against either County or JCSD. County's Resident Engineer shall notify JCSD immediately after ordering urgently needed additional work.

JCSD shall be responsible to inspect the furnishing and installation of all JCSD Facilities and the performance of the involved work by County's contractor for compliance with the approved plans and specifications. Said inspection shall be made through and in coordination with the County's Resident Engineer. It is specifically understood that JCSD's inspection personnel shall have the authority, through the County's Resident Engineer, to enforce JCSD's plans and specifications for the JCSD Facilities, which authority shall include the authority to require that any and all unacceptable materials, workmanship and/or installation be replaced, repaired or corrected by County's contractor without cost to JCSD. All inspection costs incurred by JCSD will be solely paid by JCSD. Contract administration costs attributable to JCSD facilities shall also be paid by JCSD, and shall be a fixed amount of 1.5% of the contract amount for JCSD Facilities. Administrative costs shall include costs for coordination, insertion of JCSD prepared plans and specifications in County's bid documents, bidding, preparation of contracts, administration of contract, and other tasks associated with the administration of the JCSD Facilities. County and JCSD agree that the estimate for administrative costs shall be the final costs, and that an actual accounting of costs would be burdensome.

Said contract administration costs do not include negotiations for contract change orders and claims resolution related to the JCSD Facilities, which costs shall be borne separately by JCSD.

7. RECIPROCAL INDEMNIFICATION

JCSD and County each hereby agree to indemnify, defend, save and hold harmless the other party and their respective officers, agents, servants and employees, of and from any liabilities, claims, demands, suits, action and cause of action arising out

of or in any manner connected with any act of omission of such indemnifying party, performed in connection with such party's duties and obligations hereunder.

8. COUNTY TO PROVIDE INSURANCE

For the period during which County or its contractor(s) controls the job site, County will provide, or cause to be provided, for the entire period of construction, a policy of worker's compensation insurance and comprehensive general liability insurance with coverage broad enough to include the contractual obligation it may have under the construction contract and having a combined single limit of liability in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 covering JCSD officers, employees and agents as additional insureds.

9. SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS

This agreement shall inure to the benefit of and be binding on each of the parties and their successors and assigns.

10. NOTICES

11. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Agreement shall become effective upon acceptance hereof by the County and JCSD and by execution by their respective authorized representatives.

12. GENERAL

This Agreement contains the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the matters herein provided for and may only be amended by a subsequent written agreement executed by all parties. This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original but which together shall constitute a single agreement.

13. PREVAILING WAGE

The County and any other person or entity hired to perform services on the Project are alerted to the requirements of California Labor Code Sections 1770 et seq., which require the payment of prevailing wages for the construction of public works, as defined therein. The County shall ensure compliance with these prevailing wage requirements by any person or entity hired to perform the construction of the JCSD Facilities.

REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF JURUPA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT FACILITIES AS PART OF THE VAN BUREN BRIDGE AND ROADWAY REPLACEMENT PROJECT BY RIVERSIDE COUNTY

This Amendment No. One is made and entered into this 4th day of Dec., 2012, by and between the **Jurupa Community Services District** (hereinafter, "JCSD"), a public agency and the **COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE**, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter "County").

RECITALS

- (A) County and JCSD entered into a Reimbursement Agreement, hereinafter referred to as "Agreement" on September 2, 2008 for the construction of two 24-Inch sewer pipelines and one 18-inch recycled water pipeline (hereinafter "JCSD Facilities") within the replacement bridge on Van Buren Boulevard over the Santa Ana River, which specified the terms and conditions under which the JCSD Facilities are to be financed, designed, administered and constructed.
- (B) County, as lead agency, advertized for public construction bids, which were received on April 8, 2009. The low responsive bid for the County's bridge construction work, hereinafter "Project", including the work of constructing JCSD Facilities, was submitted by the firm of Griffith Company, referred to herein as "Contractor". The low bid amount for the construction of JCSD Facilities, as bid by Contractor for Alternate Bid Schedules "A" and "B", totaled \$1,201,276. The original estimate of costs for the construction of the JCSD Facilities was \$1,436,680.
- (C) JCSD approved the award of Alternate Bid Schedules "A" and "B", and County included the work of constructing JCSD facilities in its award of the construction contract with Contractor.
- (D) JCSD has requested the County to negotiate a Construction Change Order (CCO) for the extension of the Sewer pipelines beyond the original designated limits of the facilities. County has negotiated CCO number 12 with its Contractor, in the amount of \$431,785.54, and has received written concurrence from JCSD to approve the CCO and commence construction of the sewer pipeline extension. No changes to the scope of work for the reclaimed water pipeline have been requested by JCSD.

- (E) Section 2 of the Agreement provided that if changes were made during construction requiring additional work that work should be funded by JCSD.
- (F) The County and JCSD now desire to amend the Agreement by this Amendment to provide for the funding of the additional work, as requested by JCSD.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed as follows:

1. Exhibit "A", described and attached to the Agreement, is hereby replaced and superseded by the attached Exhibit "A", which includes costs for pipeline improvements as originally requested by JCSD and bid by County's Contractor, and includes the costs for the additional work as requested by JCSD and as provided under CCO Number 12 to the construction contract.
2. A copy of CCO Number 12 acceptable to JCSD is attached hereto and incorporated herein, designated as Exhibit "B".
3. JCSD placed a deposit into trust with the County in the amount of \$1,441,710.00 (JCSD Check number 062245) for the original construction of the JCSD Facilities. It is mutually agreed that no additional deposit is necessary for the additional work, and the final costs will be billed by the County to JCSD after completion of all work performed by County and Contractor on behalf of JCSD.
4. Section 6 "Construction and Inspection Responsibilities" is deleted and replaced in its entirety with the following:

All JCSD Facilities furnished, constructed and installed by County's Contractor shall be installed in strict compliance with JCSD's plans and specifications. All materials furnished by County's Contractor must conform to JCSD's approved material list. Any and all deviations from said plans and specifications must be approved by JCSD, in writing, prior to being made. Change orders involving JCSD's Facilities shall not be implemented by County without JCSD's prior written approval. However, JCSD agrees that County's Resident Engineer, who is the County's on-site construction manager, may order the Change Order or additional work, in advance of receipt of written authorization from JCSD, if the County's Resident Engineer determines that additional work is urgently needed for the protection of life or property or to avoid loss of productivity that is likely to result in a delay claim against either County or JCSD. County's Resident Engineer shall request verbal approval prior to ordering such urgently needed change or additional work, and JCSD shall exercise best efforts to respond to such request for approval for change or additional work as quickly as reasonably possible. JCSD shall be responsible for delay claims asserted by the Contractor resulting from JCSD's failure to respond timely to any request for approval of a Change Order or additional work.

County's Resident Engineer shall notify JCSD immediately after ordering urgently needed change or additional work.

JCSD shall be responsible to inspect the furnishing and installation of all JCSD Facilities and the performance of the involved work by County's Contractor for compliance with the approved plans and specifications. Said inspection shall be made through and in coordination with the County's Resident Engineer. It is specifically understood that JCSD's inspection personnel shall have the authority, through the County's Resident Engineer, to enforce JCSD's plans and specifications for the JCSD Facilities, which authority shall include the authority to require that any and all unacceptable materials, workmanship and/or installation be replaced, repaired or corrected by County's Contractor without cost to JCSD. All inspection costs incurred by JCSD will be solely paid by JCSD. Contract administration costs attributable to JCSD facilities shall also be paid by JCSD, and shall be a fixed amount of 1.5% of the final contract amount for JCSD Facilities. Administrative costs shall include costs for coordination, insertion of JCSD prepared plans and specifications in County's bid documents, bidding, preparation of contracts, administration of contract, and other tasks associated with the administration of the JCSD Facilities. County and JCSD agree that the estimate for administrative costs shall be the final costs, and that an actual accounting of costs would be burdensome.

Said contract administration costs do not include negotiations for contract change orders and claims resolution related to the JCSD Facilities, which costs shall be borne separately by JCSD.

5. If any provision of the Agreement or this Amendment is held to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, this Amendment shall be interpreted and enforceable as if such provision were severed or limited, but only to the extent necessary to render such provision and this Amendment enforceable.
6. This Amendment shall in all respects be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of California applicable to agreements made and fully to be performed in such state, without giving effect to conflicts of law principles.
7. This Amendment may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
8. All terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force, except as specifically modified hereby.

Contract Change Order No. 12 became necessary to construct the sewer forcemain extension from Sta 84+32 to 97+44 (Alt No. 2), sewer forcemain extension at the intersection of Van Buren Blvd. and blow-off assembly at Sta 112+73 in accordance with Jurupa Community Services District red lined plans and standards. These changes were incorporated by JCSD in anticipation of the future sewer forcemain connection to the City of Riverside treatment plant.

The inclusion of the installation of the 24" sewer forcemain extension in conjunction with the bridge project promotes convenience and safety for the travelling public. There will be less impact to the public since the construction of the Van Buren Bridge project is in progress.

Dear Mr. Saglam:

As discussed in our recent meeting in which we reviewed the merits of extending the Jurupa Community Services District's (JCSD) sewer forcemain within the current bridge construction project, this letter is to provide the JCSD's commitment to fund the subject construction work. The project scope of work and associated funding obligations were reviewed and approved by our Board of Directors on September 12, 2011. The benefits of conducting the work now rather than deferring construction, includes a reduction in public inconvenience, a reduction in multiagency coordination efforts, and a reduction in facility construction costs.

Therefore, in accordance with a request made by JCSD to the Riverside County Transportation Department, Gabriel Munoz of your staff has solicited alternative construction cost proposals from the subject project's contractor (Griffith Company) to extend portions of the JCSD Regional Forcemain on both the north and south sides of the bridge project.

Of the four alternative proposals provided, JCSD has selected the one entitled "Sewer Forcemain Extension STA 84+32 Alternative 2 (Attachment A) in the amount of \$431,785.54. We note that this financial commitment represents a combination of two existing change order items, contractual impact costs and funding for the new construction scope. As indicated in Griffith Company's cost proposal letter, "If they receive a contract change order by October 7, 2011, the sewer forcemain extension work will have zero impact on the current construction schedule." For ease of review, the specific work included in the selected alternative is shown on the plans and associated details provided in Attachment B.


Attachment C provides an overall program cost summary of the JCSD work to date and proposed scope additions. As shown, the subject forcemain extension work will
