On motion of Supervisor Benoit, seconded by Supervisor Tavaglione, and duly carried by unanimous vote, IT WAS ORDERED that the meeting of Tuesday, December 11, 2012, is adjourned in memory of H.C. "Chuck" Hayes, an 85-year-old longtime resident of Blythe and retired Sergeant with the Riverside County Sheriff's Department.

Born on October 31, 1927 in Tishomingo, Oklahoma, Chuck was a "proud descendent of the great warrior Chickasaw Chief Piomingo." At the age of seven, he moved to Arizona with his parents and sister and then relocated to Corona, California where he graduated from high school. In 1959, he settled in Blythe with his family when he went to work for the Riverside County Sheriff's Department.

As a man who strived for excellence, Chuck loved airplanes and flying and obtained his pilot's license at an early age. After building his own airplane, a Pietenpol Air Cleaner, his maiden flight became a celebrated event in Blythe.

Chuck was a loving husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, and friend whose memory and passionate spirit will live forever in the hearts of those who knew and loved him! He will be dearly missed.

The Board of Supervisors commemorates his service to the County of Riverside.
