SUBJECT: Temescal Valley Community Fund – Approval of the Transfer of Funds

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors direct the Department of Environmental Health to transfer \$500,000 to the Economic Development Agency from the Temescal Valley Community Fund for Temescal Valley community improvements.

BACKGROUND: On June 15, 2004, the Board of Supervisors approved Resolution No. 2004-285, establishing the Temescal Valley Community Fund. On October 25, 2005, the Board approved an expenditure of \$80,255 from the Temescal Valley Community Fund to contract with PDS West for the development of design guideline enhancements for the Temescal Valley area. The EDA is charged with the responsibility of developing various improvements identified within the Temescal Valley design guidelines. In order to deliver the community improvements contained with the Temescal Valley guidelines, numerous tasks will be undertaken by EDA, including but not limited to: design, construction, environmental, planning, project management and real estate services. In its effort to effectuate certain community improvements, EDA is currently managing the contract with PDS West and providing project management and real property services to assist to development of the Temescal Valley community monument signs.

Therefore, I recommend the transfer of \$500,000 of the Temescal Valley Community Fund to EDA in order implement the series of community improvements identified for the Temescal Valley area.
