BACKGROUND:

The Desert Recreation District is hosting the 13th Annual Palm Desert Senior Games and International Festival on February 7-10th. Over 1,000 adult and senior athletes compete in dozens of Olympic-style events, including track & field, soccer and swimming. For many seniors, the event serves as qualification for regional, state and national Senior Games.

Angel View is a non-profit organization that helps children and adults with disabilities reach their maximum potential. They provide 24 hour residential nursing care at 19 group homes; a therapeutic Adult Day Program and outreach to children with disabilities throughout the Coachella Valley.

Joslyn Center provides services and programs for mature adults. Programs vary from exercise, arts and crafts, life-long learning and volunteering opportunities.

Community Connect provides 24 hour, 7 days a week list of resources for residents seeking information about health and human services, housing, education, and other essential programs.

ACT for MS provides programs that include weekly strength training, exercise and cardiovascular health programs, monthly therapeutic and flexible massage, educational workshops and seminars, assistance with equipment products designed to improve safety, mobility and independence.

RRCMC Foundation" Festival of Trees raises funds for the purchase of desperately needed and often life saving equipment for the Medical Center, especially units that serve children.

I would like to use Fourth District Community Improvement funds to assist these worthy organizations in meeting the needs of our community.
