RE: Construction of traffic signal at the intersection of Ontario Avenue/Temescal Canyon Road and El Cerrito Road/Minnesota Road, El Cerrito community.

January 3, 2013

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BACKGROUND: The Transportation Improvement Program provides for the construction of a traffic signal at the intersection of Ontario Avenue/Temescal Canyon Road and El Cerrito Road/Minnesota Road in the El Cerrito community. The proposed traffic signal will improve safety by providing protected traffic movements and pedestrian crossings.

Additionally, the project includes installing signing and striping, a new raised median with colored stamped concrete, new ADA compliant curb ramps, construction of driveway approaches, curb and gutter, sidewalk, bus stop pad, pavement reconstruction, installation of a new asphalt parking lot, and an onsite waste water treatment system on private property.

These proposed improvements are within the County's right of way (ROW) and partially within privately owned property; accordingly, ROW acquisition was necessary on the northeast corner of Temescal Canyon Road and Minnesota Road. The Board of Supervisors authorized the acquisition of property to build the proposed improvements on July 31, 2012 (Item 3.19) through a negotiation with the property owner to convey 128 square feet in permanent easement. As part of the consideration for this conveyance, the County will replace the existing parking lot, install a new onsite waste water treatment system, and relocate the business sign to another portion of the property.

Annual traffic signal operation and maintenance costs are estimated at \$5,500 to be funded from gas tax.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental clearance is complete.

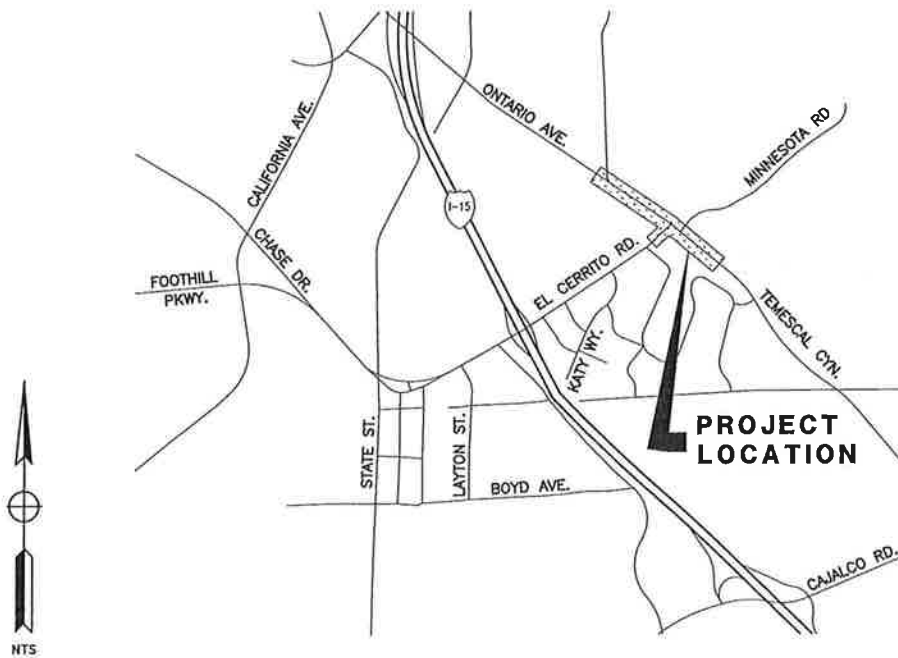
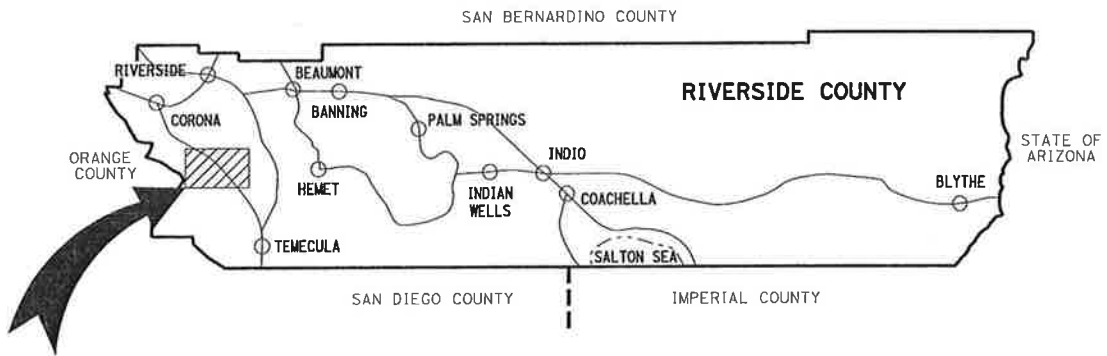
