RE: Construction of traffic signal at the intersection of Ramon Road & Monterey Avenue/Sierra Del Sol, Thousand Palms area.

January 16, 2013

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BACKGROUND:

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the construction of a traffic signal and lighting, at the intersection of Ramon Road and Monterey Avenue/Sierra Del Sol, Thousand Palms area. This intersection meets warrant for traffic signal control. The proposed traffic signal will improve safety by assigning right-of-way to provide orderly movements of vehicular and pedestrian traffic.

The work includes the installation of traffic signals, safety lighting, sidewalk and access ramps, and associated improvements.

Annual traffic signal operation and maintenance costs are estimated at \$5,500 to be funded from gas tax.

The Development Impact Fee (DIF) program, which is governed under Ordinance 659.6, allows for the use of DIF funds for traffic signal facilities.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental clearance is complete.

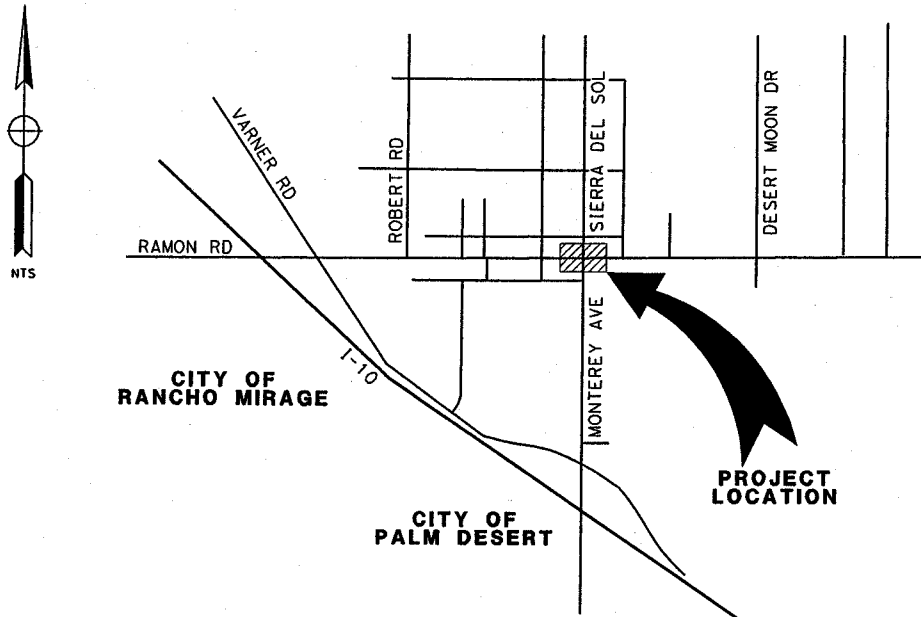
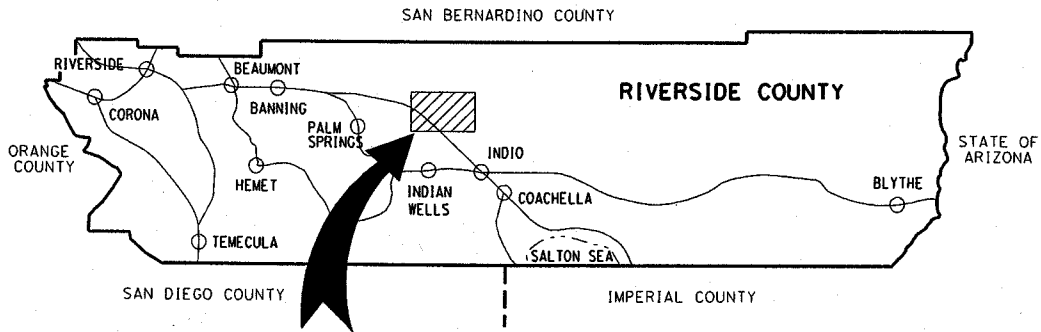
