SUBJECT: Appointment to the Indian Gaming Local Community Benefit Committee

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors appoint Michael Wilson, of the Indio City Council, to the Indian Gaming Local Community Benefit Committee.

BACKGROUND: In accordance with SB 621 (Battin and Burton), on December 16, 2003, the Board of Supervisors appointed three city and two county representatives and one alternate in each category to the Indian Gaming Local Community Benefit Committee (CBC). Gene Gilbert, of the Indio City Council, served as an alternate on the committee.

Mr. Gilbert's elected term on the Indio City Council ended, creating a vacancy on the committee. Michael Wilson, City of Indio, is being recommended to fill the city alternate vacant term expiring on June 30, 2013, plus an additional four-year term expiring on June 30, 2017. Mr. Wilson was elected to the Indio City Council in 1995 and served until 2008. Following a short break from the city council, Mr. Wilson was re-elected in 2010.

The role of the CBC is to allocate funds from the Indian Gaming Special Distribution Fund (SDF) to local government agencies for the purpose of mitigating impacts of Tribal gaming.
