SUBJECT: Resolution No. 2013-027 - Authorizing the Waste Management Department to Apply for CalRecycle Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Grants

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Adopt Resolution No. 2013-027, authorizing the Waste Management Department to submit applications to the State of California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) for any Household Hazardous Waste grants for five (5) years from the date of adoption of this resolution; and
2. Authorize the General Manager-Chief Engineer, or designee, to execute documents and implement program(s) for any awarded funding.

BACKGROUND: The Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Grants are competitive grants made available by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) per Public Resources Code 40000 et seq, to help local governments establish or expand HHW collection programs. California cities, counties, and local agencies, including Indian reservations and rancherias, with direct responsibility for HHW management are eligible to apply. (continued)

BACKGROUND: (Continued)

Assembly Bill (AB) 1220 authorizes CalRecycle to expend funds from the Integrated Waste Management Account, upon appropriation by the Legislature, to make grants to cities, counties, or other local agencies with the responsibility for solid waste management, for local programs that help prevent the disposal of hazardous wastes at disposal sites.

Following adoption by the Board of Supervisors, this resolution will enable the Waste Management Department (Department) to apply for any grant funding offered by CalRecycle through their HHW grants. It also gives authority to the Department's General Manager-Chief Engineer, or designee, to execute all grant documents necessary to secure any awarded funds and implement programs.

6 WHEREAS, the Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) grants are competitive grants made available by the
7 California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) per Public Resources Code
8 sections 40000 et seq. to help local governments establish or expand HHW and used oil collection
9 programs; and

10 WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 40000 et seq. authorizes CalRecycle to administer various
11 Grant programs (grants) in furtherance of the State of California's (State) efforts to reduce, recycle, and
12 reuse solid waste generated in the State, thereby, preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health
13 and safety in the environment; and

15 WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the
16 application, awarding, and management of the grants; and

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18 WHEREAS, CalRecycle's grant application procedures require, among other things, an applicant's
19 governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle
20 grants.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Riverside County Board of Supervisors authorize the
23 submittal of grant application(s) to CalRecycle for all HHW grants for which Riverside County is eligible
