**BACKGROUND/APPOINTEE INFORMATION:**

Ms. Suzanne Lingold, Associate Dean Extended Learning, California State University San Marcos at Temecula, has expressed an interest in serving on the Workforce Investment Board (WIB) as an Education Representative for all districts.
