**BACKGROUND:** The COUNTY "Transportation Improvement Program" (TIP) provides for safety improvements to Leon Road, between Keller Road and Scott Road.

The County of Riverside and City of Menifee have been working together on this safety project on Leon Road. The centerline of Leon Road is the easterly city limits of the City of Menifee and the western portion is in the unincorporated County of Riverside. These improvements will improve traffic safety by reconstructing the vertical profile on a portion of Leon Road to improve sight distance, and will provide four-foot paved shoulders for safety.

The total project construction cost is estimated at \$1,550,000. Funding in the amount of \$900,000 is provided by the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) for which the County successfully competed for and obtained.

The remaining balance of \$650,000 will be split evenly between the County of Riverside and City of Menifee. The City of Menifee will be paying the County for their share over a four-year period.

Under the terms of this agreement, the County will be designated as the Lead Agency for this project due to the expertise in the development and construction of roadway safety projects.

Construction is expected to start in Spring 2013.

Each of the Parties hereto maintain and operate as a division or agency of local government, roadways within 15 16 their respective jurisdictions. B. Each of the Parties has the power to approve the expenditure of funds for the maintenance of public 17 roadways within their jurisdiction. 18 C. The Parties, as public agencies are authorized to contract with each other for the joint exercise of any 19 common power under Article I, Chapter 5, Div. 7, Title I of the Government Code (Sections 6500-6514). 20 D. The COUNTY and MENIFEE desire to improve traffic safety on Leon Road between Scott Road and Keller 21 Road. The proposed project will improve traffic safety by reconstructing the vertical profile on portions of 22 Leon Road to improve sight distance and providing four foot paved shoulders for safety (hereinafter 23 "PROJECT"). 24 E. The COUNTY and MENIFEE desire to designate the COUNTY as Lead Agency for the overall development 25 and implementation of the PROJECT. The COUNTY has extensive experience in the development and 26 implementation of roadway safety projects. The COUNTY will therefore provide the administrative, technical, 27

- F. The current COUNTY "Transportation Improvement Program" (2011/2012 TIP), as approved by the Riverside County Board of Supervisors, January 10, 2012, provides for safety improvements to Leon Road, between Scott Road and Keller Road as shown on Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein, which is located within the jurisdictional boundaries of COUNTY and MENIFEE.
- G. Major funding for the PROJECT is provided through the "Highway Safety Improvement Program" (HSIP) program for which COUNTY submitted and successfully competed for.
- H. Additional funding is from various sources including State Exchange Funds, Measure A/Western, and City of Menifee, as shown in Exhibit "B".
- The Environmental Document for the PROJECT has been prepared by COUNTY and will be approved prior to construction.
- J. The COUNTY and MENIFEE desire to define herein the terms and conditions under which said project is to be administered, engineered, coordinated, managed and constructed.
- K. California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1240.140(b) provides that "[t]wo or more public agencies may enter into an agreement for the joint exercise of their respective powers of eminent domain, whether or not possessed in common, for acquisition of property as a single parcel".
- L. The COUNTY and MENIFEE desire to designate the COUNTY as lead agency to perform activities required to acquire necessary right-of-entry for the PROJECT, including properties located in MENIFEE.
- M. Costs that apply to the construction of the PROJECT (such as preparation of bid documents, advertising of project for bids, award of contract, surveying, inspection, and materials testing ) shall be allocated proportionally between the COUNTY and the DISTRICT, as shown in Exhibit B.

# **AGREEMENT**

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

#### **SECTION 1 • COUNTY AGREES:**

- To complete, or cause to be completed, detailed Environmental and PS&E documents for the PROJECT, and secure all necessary construction permits from the regulatory agencies. The COUNTY will seek approval from Caltrans Division of Local Assistance HSIP funding.
- 2. To invoice MENIFEE yearly, but not more frequently, for three fiscal years, for reimbursement of MENIFEE share of PROJECT costs.
- 3. Nothing in this agreement is intended to commit the COUNTY to funding any portion of the PROJECT beyond the funds available as shown in Exhibit "B", attached hereto and incorporated by this reference, or shall be construed as obligating the COUNTY to provide replacement funding for any anticipated funding or to continue with the PROJECT, if funds are no longer available.
- 4. To perform activities required to acquire necessary right-of-entry for the PROJECT including appraisals, if necessary.
- 5. To coordinate utility relocations for the PROJECT.
- 6. To prepare certain right-of-way documents in compliance with all applicable State laws and regulations, if necessary. Documents to be prepared by COUNTY may include, but are not limited, to Legal Descriptions, Plats, Right-of-Way Maps and Appraisals.
- 7. To advertise, award and administer a public works contract for the construction of the PROJECT in accordance with the local Agency Public Contract Code, Federal Regulations, the California Labor Code, STATE requirements and in accordance with an encroachment permit issued by MENIFEE.
- 8. To furnish a representative to perform the function of Resident Engineer during construction of PROJECT.

  The Resident Engineer shall be independent of the construction contractor.
- 9. To furnish qualified support staff to assist the Resident Engineer in, but not limited to, construction surveys, soils and compaction tests, measurement and computation of quantities, testing of construction materials, checking submittals, preparation of estimates and reports, preparation of as-built drawings, and other inspection and staff services necessary to assure that the construction is performed in accordance with the plans and specifications.
- 10. To construct the PROJECT in accordance with approved plans and specifications.
- 11. To provide separate quantities and accounting for MENIFEE share of the PROJECT.

To issue, at no cost to COUNTY or its consultants and contractors, upon proper application by the COUNTY or COUNTY's consultants or contractors, an encroachment permit authorizing entry onto MENIFEE's right-ofway to perform construction, survey and other investigative activities required for preparation of

#### SECTION 4 • IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Recitals set forth above at the beginning of this Agreement are incorporated herein by this reference.
- 2. The total cost to complete construction of the PROJECT, including surveying, inspection, and materials
- 9 testing is estimated to be One million five hundred and fifty thousand (\$1,550,000), as shown in Exhibit B.
  - 3. Funding for the PROJECT provided through the "Highway Safety Improvement Program" (HSIP) program is anticipated to be of Nine hundred thousand (\$900,000), which will be shared equally between COUNTY and
- 12 MENIFEE as shown in Exhibit B.
  - 4. PROJECT costs with that exceed the funding from the "Highway Safety Improvement Program" is anticipated to be Six hundred fifty thousand (\$650,000), which will shared equally between COUNTY and MENIFEE as shown in Exhibit B.
  - 5. The COUNTY and MENIFEE acknowledge and agree that any funding shortfall for the completion of the PROJECT will be the responsibility of COUNTY and MENIFEE. In the event that adequate funds are not available to complete the PROJECT, COUNTY and MENIFEE agree to meet and confer and collectively work to identify adequate funding for PROJECT.
  - 6. MENIFEE agrees to budget for PROJECT its share at the start of each fiscal year for three fiscal years.
  - 7. Ownership and title to all materials, equipment, and appurtenances installed as part of this agreement will automatically be vested with the jurisdiction in which the improvements reside and no further agreement will be necessary to transfer ownership.
  - 8. The COUNTY shall not be responsible for any maintenance of the improvements provided by the PROJECT within MENIFEE.
  - 9. In the event that the COUNTY defaults in the performance of any of its obligations under this Agreement or materially breaches any of the provisions of this Agreement, MENIFEE shall have the option to terminate this

Agreement upon 90 days written notice to COUNTY.

- 10. In the event that MENIFEE defaults in the performance of any of its obligations under this Agreement or materially breaches any of the provisions of this Agreement, the COUNTY shall have the option to terminate this Agreement upon 90 days written notice to MENIFEE.
- 11. In the event any action is commenced to enforce or interpret any term or condition of this Agreement, in addition to costs and any other relief, the prevailing party shall be entitled to reasonable attorney's fees.
- 12. Neither MENIFEE nor any officer or employee thereof shall be responsible for any damage or liability occurring by reason of anything done or omitted to be done by the COUNTY under or in connection with any work, authority or jurisdiction delegated to the COUNTY under this Agreement. It is further agreed that pursuant to Government Code Section 895.4, the COUNTY shall fully indemnify and hold MENIFEE harmless from any liability imposed for injury (as defined by Government Code Section 810.8) occurring by reason of anything done or omitted to be done by the COUNTY under or in connection with any work, authority or jurisdiction delegated to the COUNTY under this Agreement.
- 13. Neither the COUNTY nor any officer or employee thereof shall be responsible for any damage or liability occurring by reason of anything done or omitted to be done by MENIFEE under or in connection with any work, authority or jurisdiction delegated to MENIFEE under this Agreement. It is further agreed that pursuant to Government Code Section 895.4, MENIFEE shall fully indemnify and hold the COUNTY harmless from any liability imposed for injury (as defined by Government Code Section 810.8) occurring by reason of anything done or omitted to be done by MENIFEE under or in connection with any work, authority or jurisdiction delegated to MENIFEE under this Agreement.
- 14. Nothing in the provisions of this Agreement is intended to create duties or obligations to or rights in third parties not parties to this Agreement or affects the legal liability of either party to the Agreement by imposing any standard of care with respect to the maintenance of roads different from the standard of care imposed by law.
- 15. This agreement and the exhibits herein contain the entire agreement between the parties, and are intended by the parties to completely state the agreement in full. Any agreement or representation respecting the matters dealt with herein or the duties of any party in relation thereto, not expressly set forth in this

agreement, is null and void.

16. No alteration or variation of the terms of this Agreement shall be valid unless made in writing and signed by both parties and no oral understanding or agreement not incorporated herein shall be binding on either party

hereto.

17. Each provision, term, condition, covenant and/or restriction in this Agreement shall be considered severable.

In the event that any provision, term, condition, covenant and/or restriction, or part thereof is declared invalid,

7

unconstitutional or void for any reason, such provision or part thereof shall be severed from this Agreement

and shall not affect the remainder of the Agreement, which shall continue in full force and effect.

18. This Agreement may be executed in duplicate originals, each of which is deemed to be an original.

10

19. The COUNTY and MENIFEE shall retain or cause to be retained for audit for a period of three (3) years from

11

the date of final payment, all records and accounts relating to the PROJECT.

12

20. All notices permitted or required under this Agreement shall be deemed made when delivered to the

applicable party's representative as provided in this Agreement. Such notices shall be mailed or otherwise


