SUBJECT: Approval of Contract Documents for the Construction of a Liner System within the Canyon 4 Phase 3 area at the Badlands Sanitary Landfill.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the Contract Documents for the Liner System Construction within the Canyon 4 Phase 3 area at the Badlands Sanitary Landfill; and
2. Authorize the General Manager-Chief Engineer of the Riverside County Waste Management Department to advertise for bids.

BACKGROUND: Constructing a 13-acre lateral expansion, referred to as Canyon 4 Phase 3 (C4P3), will provide an estimated eight (8) additional years of landfill airspace. A composite liner system must be constructed within the Canyon 4 Phase 3 expansion area in order to comply with the requirements of the applicable State and Federal Regulations and the Waste Discharge Requirements issued by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region.
