**Background:**

County Counsel provides legal services to the Board of Supervisors', as well as various agencies and departments of Riverside County. The Sheriff's Department has requested the need for specialized services and a dedicated attorney. A memorandum of understanding was entered into between the Sheriff's Department and the Office of County Counsel in order to solidify this request.

This department requests to add one position of Deputy County Counsel IV to accommodate the increased higher level service request and to increase appropriations to accommodate the salary expenses and revenue. The position will be fully funded by the Sheriff's Department. There will be no additional impact to the general fund as increased revenues will offset additional expenses.
