SUBJECT: Adoption of Resolution #2013-084 Authorizing the Sheriff's Department to

Submit a Grant Application to the California Department of Parks and Recreation

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors adopt Resolution #2013-084, which authorizes the Sheriff to sign and submit a grant application to the California Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation for \$162,393 to continue off-highway vehicle (OHV) law enforcement efforts in Riverside County and expand enforcement by targeting sites in the unincorporated areas of all five Supervisorial Districts.

BACKGROUND: The California Department of Parks and Recreation is currently accepting grant applications for its Off-Highway Vehicle Enforcement Program. On September 10, 2002 (3.32), the Board approved two Project Agreements with the Department for a County off-highway motor vehicle enforcement program. Christened the Riverside Off-Highway Vehicle Enforcement Program (R.O.V.E.), this innovative and effective program has put Deputies on all-terrain vehicles (ATVs) to enforce laws concerning illegal off-highway driving, dumping, driving under the influence and

The current application will begin Phase IX of the Sheriff's county-wide effort with a proposed start date of September 2013. The application requests \$162,393 to support Deputy Sheriff overtime for continued and expanded patrols in problematic areas.

The grant application requires a 25% match of the total project cost of \$216,524 in the amount of \$54,131. The Department proposes contributing an in-kind match of Special Enforcement Bureau salaries. All local match contributions will come from the Department's status quo budget. Any grant awarded will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for review and approval.

During the development of this phase of the county-wide project, the Sheriff requested public comment via a posting on the Department's web site and through mailings to interested individuals.

floor of the County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, CA, approves the filing of an Application(s) for an Off-Highway Vehicle Grant or Cooperative Agreement and;

- Approves the filing of an Application(s) for an Off-Highway Vehicle Grant or Cooperative Agreement; and
- 2. Certifies that Riverside County understands its legal obligations to the State upon approval of the Grant; and
