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BACKGROUND:

The contract documents have been approved as to form by County Counsel. A brief project description and location map are attached.

The General Manager-Chief Engineer has determined that the proposed project meets the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) statutory exemption cited in Public Resources Code §21080.21 stating that CEQA does not apply to any project of less than one mile in length within a public street or highway or any other public right-of-way for the installation of new pipeline or the maintenance, repair, restoration, reconditioning, relocation, replacement, removal, or demolition of an existing pipeline. For purposes of this exemption, "pipeline" includes subsurface facilities but does not include any surface facility related to the operation of the underground facility. A CEQA Notice of Exemption has been prepared and will be filed with the Clerk-Recorder's Office in accordance with CEQA.

The proposed project is not within the Criteria Area or Public/Quasi-Public (P/QP) lands set forth in and established by the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). The proposed project site does not meet the MSHCP definition of riparian/riverine areas or vernal pools. In addition, the proposed project lacks suitable habitat for the species listed in Section 6.1.2 of the MSHCP. Therefore, no analysis or survey is required. The proposed project is not located within a mapped survey area for the Narrow Endemic Plant Species. Therefore, no habitat assessment or survey area for plant, amphibian, mammal species or Burrowing Owls. Therefore, no habitat assessment or survey is required under Section 6.3.2 of the MSHCP.
