BACKGROUND:

On September 13, 2011, the Board of Supervisors approved the award of the construction agreement to The Sun Group for the Palm Desert Library Renovation project. Pursuant to the general conditions of the contract, the Economic Development Agency (EDA) is currently retaining 10% of all progress payments to The Sun Group. The general conditions of the contract state that after the 50% completion of the contract work, if satisfactory progress is being made, the county has the sole discretion to reduce the retention to a minimum of 5% of the contract. The Sun Group has completed 98% of the contract work and satisfactory progress has been made. Therefore, EDA recommends that the contract retention be reduced to 5%. This Board action will release \$93,219 in retained funds to the contractor.

Sufficient funds for this project are budgeted for FY 2012/13. All costs associated with this project will be funded by the City of Palm Desert Redevelopment Agency, Library Improvement District Fund, thus no net county costs will be incurred.
