SUBJECT: Confirm the appointment and salary of Mark A. Hake as Chief Probation Officer of Riverside County

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors confirms the appointment and salary of Mr. Mark A. Hake as Chief Probation Officer of Riverside County effective May 16, 2013.

BACKGROUND: The County Human Resources Department conducted a nationwide recruitment to fill the Chief Probation Officer vacancy for the Riverside County Probation Department. Interviews were conducted by the Court/County Chief Probation Officer (CPO) Governance Committee which was established on February 26, 2013 by a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Superior Court and the County of Riverside establishing a joint responsibility in the recruitment and interview of the CPO when a vacancy occurs.

Hake as Chief Probation Officer of Riverside County by Order Number 04.24.13 (Attachment A).

ORDER NO. 04.24.13

ORDER APPOINTING MARK A. HAKE AS CHIEF PROBATION OFFICER OF RIVERSIDE COUNTY

The Court finds as follows:

On or about October 30, 2012, Alan M. Crogan announced his retirement and tendered his resignation as Chief Probation Officer for Riverside County, effective December 26, 2012.

The County has publicly announced the opening of the position of Chief Probation Officer. The County and the Court worked closely together to solicit the most highly qualified applicants to be considered for the position. Each application was reviewed by court and county personnel. Each application was reviewed and considered in accordance with the quantitative and qualitative requirements and criteria identified in the public announcement of the open position.

Riverside County is not a charter county which prescribes a method of appointment and tenure for probation officers. Riverside County is not part of a merit or civil service system governing the methods of appointment and tenure of probation officers.

Cal. Welf. & Inst. Code § 270 exclusively controls the manner in which a probation officer is appointed. Accordingly, after careful review and consideration of all qualified applicants, the court finds that Mark A. Hake is the most qualified applicant for 1 2

the position and meets and/or exceeds the announced requirements and criteria for the position.

On April 24, 2013, the Honorable Paul Dickerson, the Presiding Judge of the Riverside Superior Court Juvenile Court (and the undersigned herein), directed the Riverside Juvenile Justice Commission to nominate Mark A. Hake for the position of Chief Probation Officer of Riverside County as required under Cal. Welf. & Inst. Code § 270. On April 24, 2013, the Commission duly nominated Mark A. Hake for the position of Chief Probation Officer of Riverside County.

Based on the foregoing, IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Mark A. Hake is appointed Chief Probation Officer of The County of Riverside effective forthwith. Mark A. Hake will act as the Chief Probation Officer for both adult and juvenile services.
- 2. Mark A. Hake shall assume all of the duties and responsibilities of Chief Probation Officer of Riverside County as prescribed by the relevant job description, statutes, regulations and laws governing said duties and responsibilities.
- 3. In light of this ORDER, the position of Interim Chief Probation Officer, previously held by Mark A. Hake is terminated forthwith.
