SUBJECT: Larry Smith Correctional Facility Subvention Agreement


RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board: 1) approve a general fund subvention agreement with the City of Banning, which would extend the MOU approved on January 23, 2007; and 2) direct that the agreement be returned for approval within 60 days.


BACKGROUND: The Smith Correctional Facility in Banning is proposed for expansion. The existing facility capacity of approximately 1,500 inmate beds may be expanded by a range of 400-1600 beds. As the Board is aware, the Sheriff's Department has a significant custody deficit countywide, and this expansion is critical to maintain public safety. We have discussed the public safety expansion with the City of Banning.

In recognition of this, we recommend continuing the existing subvention to the City of Banning for public safety purposes, as follows:

- A General Fund Subvention was established at \$450,000 annually in May 2009 with a CPI adjustment each year. The new allocation will begin with the expiration of the current agreement, assuming that new construction is underway, and will have a CPI adjustment up to 3.0% annually.
- The payments will continue for 1.25 years per 100 new beds constructed.
- Banning has agreed to use the subvention payment for public safety officers.

Although a nexus study can be pursued to evaluate the measurable impacts of such development at the Smith Correctional Facility, these offsets demonstrate the County's willingness to work collaboratively with the City and provide for the safety of residents throughout the County of Riverside.
