SUBJECT: Waiver of Lake Cahuilla Park Fee for Coachella Valley and Desert Mirage High School Cross Country Teams.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors authorize the Regional Park and Open-Space District to waive the use fee of the facility for the two high school cross country training teams from Coachella Valley and Desert Mirage.

BACKGROUND:

Departmental Concurrence

The Coachella Valley and Desert Mirage Cross Country Training Teams would like to have access to Lake Cahuilla Park to train for the period from September to November on a recurring annual basis, subject to the submittal of an annual calendar by both schools and approval by the General Manager of the Park District. The students will use the facility one time a week for practices and will host cross country meets that will include local high schools. The total estimated waived cost is less than \$1000.00 per year. The high school programs have a limited budget and are unable to cover this cost.

There is minimal impact to the park by this use and it is an ideal location for cross county training purposes.

We would like to support our young people in their efforts to exercise and to encourage the use of this park by the surrounding community.
