SUBJECT: Delegation of Successor Agency Actions and Functions to the Riverside County Executive Office

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Adopt Resolution No. 2013-138, delegating performance of the actions and functions of the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside to the Riverside County Executive Office; and,
2. Authorize transmittal to the Oversight Board, the Riverside County Auditor-Controller's Office, and the State of California Department of Finance.

BACKGROUND: On January 10, 2012, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 2012-034, designating the County of Riverside as the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside, and further delegated the performance of the actions and functions of the Successor Agency to the Riverside County EDA. Resolution No. 2012-034 was deemed effective on February 1, 2012, which was the dissolution date of all redevelopment agencies in the State of California.

On May 21, 2013 (item 3-3) the Board directed that administration of the Successor Agency be shifted to the Riverside County Executive Office (CEO). It is convenient to make the formal transition at the beginning of the new fiscal year. Resolution No. 2013-138, attached for consideration and approval, delegates performance of the actions and functions of the Successor Agency to the CEO, effective July 1, 2013.

The project management function will remain with EDA through completion of ongoing projects. CEO and EDA will work together to reimburse project costs from Successor Agency funds, and to prepare required state reports.

7 **WHEREAS**, on January 10, 2012, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution
8 No. 2012-034, in which the County of Riverside accepted the designation as the
9 Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside, and
10 further delegated the actions and functions performed by the Successor Agency to the
11 Riverside County Economic Development Agency;

12 **WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 2012-034 was deemed effective February 1, 2012,
13 which was the date of dissolution for all redevelopment agencies in the State of
14 California; and,

15 **WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors delegates the actions and functions to be
16 performed as Successor Agency to the Riverside County Executive Office; and,

17 **WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors authorizes transmittal to the Oversight
18 Board, the Riverside County Auditor-Controller's Office, and the State of California
19 Department of Finance.

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, AND DETERMINED** by the
21 Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside as follows:

22 **Section 1. Delegation of Actions and Functions of Successor Agency.**

The Riverside County Board of Supervisors delegates the actions and functions to be
performed by the Successor Agency to the Riverside County Executive Office.

24 **Section 2. Transmittals.** The Riverside County Board of Supervisors
25 authorizes transmittal of this resolution to the Oversight Board, the Riverside County
26 Auditor-Controller's Office, and the State of California Department of Finance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect as of July 1, 2013.
