SUBJECT: Alternative Method for Distribution of Property Tax – Teeter Plan

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors adopts Resolution No. 2013-131 Accepting the Resolution of the City of Eastvale Desiring to Participate in the Alternative Method of Distribution.

BACKGROUND: On October 12, 1993 the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 93-402 implementing the Alternative Method for Distribution of Tax Levies and Collections as allowed by Section 4701 et seq. of the Revenue and Taxation Code. Section 4715 allows for municipalities to request participation in the Alternative Method. The County must act by resolution on or before July 15th of the fiscal year. Resolution No. 2013-131 addresses this issue for the 2013-14 fiscal year.

5 THE ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF DISTRIBUTION

7 WHEREAS, Chapter 3 of Part 8 of Division 1 of the Revenue and Taxation Code of the State of
8 California (hereinafter the "Revenue and Taxation Code"), beginning with Section 4701 thereof,
9 authorizes the County of Riverside (hereinafter the "County") to adopt the alternative method of
10 distribution of tax levies and collections and of tax sale proceeds set forth therein (hereinafter the
11 "Alternative Procedure"); and

12 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (hereinafter the "Board") of the County adopted Resolution
13 No. 93-402 on October 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 4702 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, stating
14 the County, beginning with the 1993-94, would utilize the Alternative Procedure; and

15 WHEREAS, the City of Eastvale has adopted a resolution stating their desire to participate in the
16 Alternative Procedure beginning in the 2013-14 Fiscal Year;

17 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED by the
18 Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside in regular session assembled on June 18, 2013, as
19 follows:

20 Pursuant to Section 4715 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, the County accepts the resolution
21 of those public districts identified in Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and by this reference
22 incorporated herein and extends to them the Alternative Procedure beginning in Fiscal Year 2013-14.

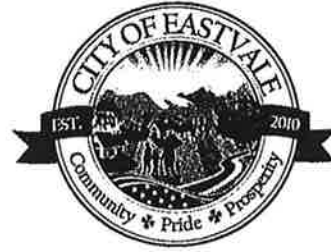

RESOLUTION NO. 13-10

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EASTVALE,
CALIFORNIA, MADE PURSUANT TO SECTION 4715 OF THE REVENUE AND
TAXATION CODE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA AGREEING TO PARTICIAPTE
IN THE ALTERNATIVE METHOD FOR DISTRIBUTION OF TAX LEVIES AND
COLLECTIONS AND OF TAX SALE PROCEEDS ADOPTED BY THE COUNTY OF
RIVERSIDE**

WHEREAS, chapter 3, of part 8 of division 1 of the Revenue and Taxation Code of the State of California (hereinafter the "Revenue and Taxation Code") beginning with Section 4701 thereof, authorizes the County of Riverside (hereinafter the "County") to adopt the alternative method of distribution of tax levies and collection and of tax sale proceeds as set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, The City of Eastvale (hereinafter the "City") is a public agency and taxing agency for which the County levies and collects taxes but for which the County Treasury is not the legal depository; and

WHEREAS, Section 4715 of the Revenue and Taxation Code allows a public agency for which the County Treasury is not the legal depository to agree, by resolution, to participate in the alternative method of distribution of tax levies and collections and of tax sales proceeds; and

WHEREAS, The City desires to participate in the alternative method of distribution of tax levies and collection and of tax sale proceeds;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the City Council of the City of Eastvale resolves as follows:

1. In a meeting assembled on May 8, 2013, that the City of Eastvale agrees to participate in the alternative method of distribution of tax levies and collection and of tax sale proceeds for the fiscal year 2013-2014.
2. This resolution shall take immediate effect upon its adoption and shall remain in effect for each fiscal year thereafter unless rescinded pursuant to the provision of Chapter 3 Part 8 of Division 1 of the Revenue and Taxation Code.
3. That the City is hereby directed to file a certified copy of the resolution with the County Board of Supervisors, Riverside County Auditor/Controller and Riverside County Tax Assessor.


