**BACKGROUND:**

The Transportation Improvement Program provides for the reconstruction of Tenaja Road from Clinton Keith Road to Sierra Ellena Road, a distance of 1.5 miles, in the La Cresta area. The existing pavement is in poor condition and requires rehabilitation.

The planned improvements include grinding and paving of the existing pavement, including the installation of pavement reinforcing fabric to provide for longer pavement life. Safety improvement items in the work include striping, reflective pavement markers, metal beam guard railing, and the construction of a pavement "safety edge." This tapered shoulder is engineered to enable drivers who drift off of the paved surface to return to the traveled surface safely.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

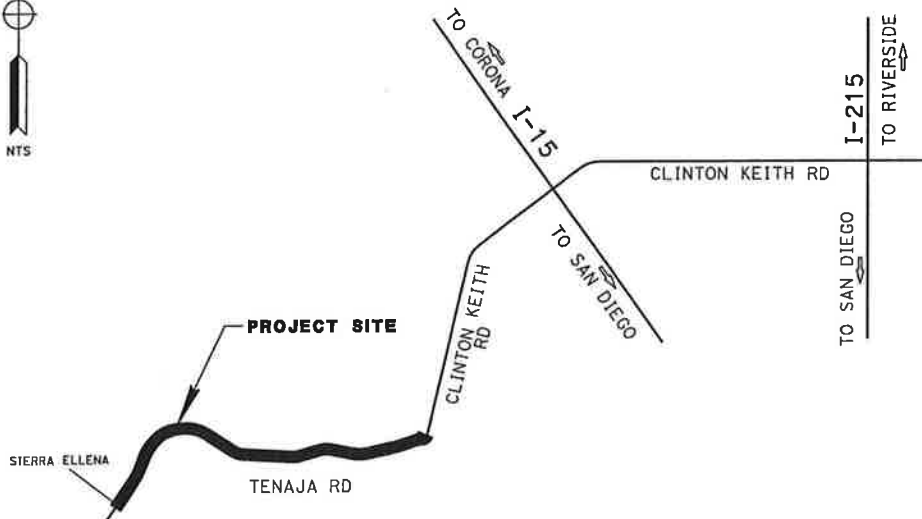
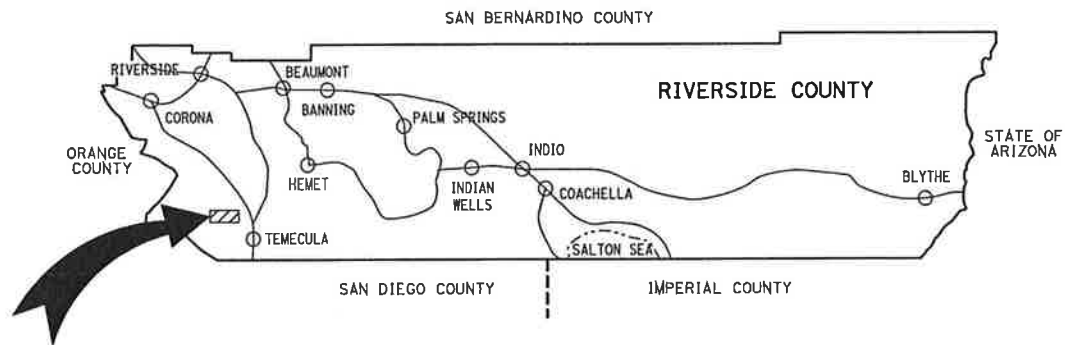
