**SUBJECT:** Resolution No. 2013-146 - Authorizing the Waste Management Department to Apply for CalRecycle Beverage Container Grants

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Adopt Resolution No. 2013-146, authorizing the Waste Management Department (Department) to submit applications to the State of California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) for any beverage container grants for five (5) years from the date of adoption of this resolution, and
2. Authorize the General Manager-Chief Engineer, or designee, to execute documents and implement program(s) for any awarded funding.

**BACKGROUND:** Following adoption by the Board of Supervisors, this resolution will enable the Department to apply for any grant funding offered by CalRecycle through their Beverage Container Grant Program. It also gives authority to the Department's General Manager-Chief Engineer, or designee, to execute all grant documents necessary to secure any awarded funds and implement programs. Such programs may include promotion of beverage container recycling at multi-family dwellings and businesses.

3 **AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATION(S) FOR ANY BEVERAGE CONTAINER**  
4 **CALRECYCLE GRANTS FOR WHICH THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE IS ELIGIBLE**

6 WHEREAS, Beverage Container grants are competitive grants made available by the California  
7 Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) per Public Resources Code sections  
8 40000 et seq. to help local governments establish or expand beverage container recycling programs; and

9  
10 WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 40000 et seq. authorizes CalRecycle to administer various  
11 Grant programs (grants) in furtherance of the State of California's (State) efforts to reduce, recycle, and  
12 reuse solid waste generated in the State, thereby, preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health  
13 and safety in the environment; and

15 WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority, CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the  
16 application, awarding, and management of the grants; and

18 WHEREAS, CalRecycle's grant application procedures require, among other things, an applicant's  
19 governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle  
20 grants.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Riverside County Board of Supervisors authorize the  
23 submittal of grant application(s) to CalRecycle for all Beverage Container grants for which Riverside  
24 County is eligible for; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Riverside County Waste Management Department's General  
2 Manager-Chief Engineer, or his/her designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name  
3 of the County of Riverside all grant documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements,  
4 amendments and requests for payment, necessary to secure grant funds and implement the approved grant  
5 programs; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this authorization is effective for five (5) years from the date of  
8 adoption of this Resolution.
