BACKGROUND: The Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) has allocated funding to the County under the Federal Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (JABG) 2013/2014 Program. The purpose of this funding is to promote development or continuation of local juvenile justice programs that hold juvenile offenders accountable to the community and courts. The allocation to Riverside County for expenditures during Fiscal Year 2013-2014 is \$107,836, and with a 10% local match (\$11,982), the total project cost is \$119,818.

In Fiscal Year 2013-2014, JABG funding of \$81,234 will be used to support the collection of data for the Coachella Valley Violent Gang Task Force by reimbursing the salary and benefits of an Office Assistant II and a portion of a Deputy salary and benefits from the Riverside County Sheriff's Department.

The balance of the JABG funding, \$26,602, will be made available for reimbursement to the host city for the Coachella Valley Violent Gang Task Force for expenditures on behalf of the Gang Task Force for services and supplies. The City of La Quinta is serving as the host city for FY 2013-2014 and will fund their share of the match. The Sheriff's Department will prepare a funding agreement between the city and county.

The allocation of project funding to the two agencies will be as follows:



5 **RIVERSIDE, AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF JUVENILE ACCOUNTABILITY BLOCK GRANT**

6 WHEREAS the County of Riverside desires to receive and utilize federal grant
7 funds available through the Juvenile Accountability Block Grants (JABG) Program
8 administered by the Board of State and Community Corrections (hereafter referred to as
9 BSCC).

10 BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of
11 Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on _____, that
12 the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside does hereby:

- 13 1. Authorize, on behalf of the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors, the
14 Sheriff, the Undersheriff, the Assistant Sheriff, or the Chief Deputy to act on the
15 County of Riverside's behalf in grant matters to include: application
16 submission, resulting award agreements, reimbursement requests and future
17 amendments and/or modifications not increasing the award by more than 20%
18 and that do not materially change the scope of the grant project;
- 19 2. Agree to provide all matching funds required for said project, and abide by the
20 statutes and regulations governing the JABG Program as set forth by the
21 BSCC; and
- 22 3. Assure that the grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant
23 expenditures controlled by this body.
