

BACKGROUND: The County Transportation Improvement Program provides for improvements to Washington Street in the Woodcrest area and Harley John Road in the Lake Mathews area of Riverside County.

The following are the limits of proposed work:

1. Washington Street: Krameria Avenue to southerly of Mariposa Avenue

2. Harley John Road: Scottsdale Road to Cajalco Road

For Washington Street, the existing pavement will be removed and new asphalt concrete (AC) pavement and aggregate base will be placed. For Harley John Road, the existing AC pavement will be recycled in place and overlaid with new AC pavement. The cross gutters at Via Los Caballeros are in poor condition and will be replaced. The existing access ramps that do not meet the current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements will be improved to meet the requirements. The roads will be improved with the "safety edge" feature that helps reduce rollover accidents. New thermoplastic pavement markings, painted traffic stripes, and reflective pavement markers will be installed.

Future improvements include a new traffic signal, minor road widening, new access ramps, and cross gutters at Washington Street and Krameria Avenue, together with road reconstruction from Krameria Avenue to Van Buren Boulevard, which are planned for mid-June 2014, after school is out for the summer.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental clearance is complete.




