**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Riverside Police Foundation - \$2,500** funding will go to support youth programs such as Riverside Police Activities League, Youth Court, OWE and Explorers.
2. **Riverside Public Library Foundation \$1,000** Funding will go towards helping purchase much needed electronic equipment such as a media box and a digital microfilm reader/printer/scanner.
3. **Assistance League of Temecula -\$2,500** to support their Operation School Bell program. Funding will be used to purchase new school-appropriate clothing for disadvantage schoolchildren (K-12) at Lake Elsinore Unified School District.
