

**SUBJECT:** Support Whiteside Manor's HUD Application Serving Special Populations

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors Support the HUD Application of Whiteside Manor and Acknowledge Their Service to the "Special Population" of Homeless, Mentally Ill Substance Abusers

**BACKGROUND:** Whiteside Manor is a Riverside based dual-diagnosed treatment program that has been the recipient of a HUD Homeless SHP Grant since 1996. They have accepted homeless, mentally ill, substance abuse clients from the entire County of Riverside. Due to the success of this program, HUD has renewed their grant annually for the past 18 years. HUD is now leaning towards permanent housing for the homeless and away from transitional housing. However, HUD has excepted "Special Populations" and Whiteside Manor's clients are considered a "Special Population" due to mental illness. Whiteside Manor is asking for the support of the Board of Supervisors in acknowledging their excellent work in supporting clients considered to be a "Special Population" for the purpose of the HUD Homeless SHP Grant.
