**BACKGROUND:** On July 24, 2013, the Mayor of Eastvale approved the Second Amendment to the law enforcement services Agreement with the County Sheriff's Department. This Amendment modifies the level of law enforcement service provided by the Sheriff's Department with the addition of 10 hours to the average level of daily Patrol service hours, the equivalent of two Deputy Sheriff positions. County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form.

Sheriff's staff has recommended budget adjustments that correspond with the positions starting the first pay period of 2014. The Department is recommending these budget adjustments now as it could not anticipate the expenditures and include them in its FY 2013-14 budget. All costs for this service will be fully recovered through Board-approved rates.
