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**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Riverside Unified School District - \$1,000** funding will be used for the Pathways to Higher Education Conference which hopes to bring 300-600 students together to discuss topics such as the college application, financial aid, preparing personal narratives and the DREAM Act.
- 2. Catholic Charities -\$2,500-** to support their goal of providing utility assistance, food assistance programs and counseling services to those in need.
- 3. Junior League of Riverside -\$2,500 funding** will be used to support their FitRiverside project which consists of 6 week sessions of free fitness activities at Bobby Bonds in Riverside. Additionally, over 100 free lunches will be provided.
- 4. Susan G. Komen Inland Empire -\$5,000 funding** will be used to help fund Breast Health Services for 1<sup>st</sup> District residents.
- 5. Community Connect-\$500** funding will be used to support the 16<sup>th</sup> Annual "Expanding Nonprofit Impact" Conference which will assist local non-profit agencies with valuable information on how they can share resources, strengthen their leadership skills and create partnerships.
- 6. Temecula Valley Chamber of Commerce-\$500** funding will be used to support the Legislative Summit to be held on October 10, 2013. Participants will hear about the state of business in California, have networking opportunities, listen to guest speakers talk about education, healthcare/Insurance, business and more.
