SUBJECT: Ratify the acceptance of the Grant Agreement from PetSmart Charities, Inc. to the Riverside County Department of Animal Services for spay/neuter surgeries, vaccinations and microchips

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1) Ratify the acceptance of the grant agreement from PetSmart Charities, Inc. for spay/neuter surgeries, vaccinations and microchips in the amount of \$200,000 over a two year period (\$100,000 for 13/14) and (\$100,000 for 14/15), to the Riverside County Department of Animal Services ("RCDAS") for the effective date of September 1, 2013; and

2) Authorize the Director of Animal Services to administer all actions necessary and sign all documents related to the administration of this Grant on behalf of the County of Riverside.

BACKGROUND:

In line with our mission of working together to improve Riverside County for people and animals, RCDAS is expanding community outreach programs in the City of Jurupa Valley, with a focus on targeted spay/neuter of canines.

Subject: Ratify the acceptance of the Grant Agreement from PetSmart Charities, Inc. to the Riverside County Department of Animal Services for spay/neuter surgeries, vaccinations and microchips

BACKGROUND (Continued):

The Department's focus will be altering, vaccinating and microchipping 1900 dogs, within an identified high concern group of census blocks in the City of Jurupa Valley within two years. The program will be implemented using door-to door community outreach, a highly publicized dog licensing amnesty program, spay/neuter, and other services offered for free through our Western Riverside Shelter clinic, located in the City of Jurupa Valley. Progress will be tracked by collecting data on the number of licensed/altered dogs in the community.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The department budgets the grant funding accordingly in their department budget. No additional County funds are required.
