RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Adopt the attached Resolution #2013-238 for the 2013 Department of Energy Weatherization Assistance Program (DOE WAP);
2. Approve and direct the Auditor Controller to adjust the budget as identified in the attached Schedule A.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

On August 30, 2013, The State of California, Department of Community Services and Development (CSD) advised weatherization service providers that their 2013 DOE WAP contract would be mailed by September 10, 2013 and expects the agreement to be returned prior to September 30, 2013. In order to meet CSD's deadline, Community Action Partnership of Riverside County (CAP Riverside) requests the Board to adopt Resolution #2013-238. Failure to return the agreement by the deadline could result in loss of funding. The anticipated funding for this agreement is \$66,380 for the term September 30, 2013 through June 30, 2014.

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Impact on Citizens and Businesses

Since 1979, CAP Riverside has administered weatherization contracts for CSD. The DOE-WAP provides funding to install energy conservation measures in homes, at no cost to low-income residents of Riverside County. Home weatherization reduces energy consumption, resulting in lower utility bills for low-income residents. CAP Riverside utilizes experienced subcontractors to install allowable energy conservation measures.

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BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on **September 24, 2013**, that the Board of Supervisors accepts the 2013 Department of Energy Weatherization Assistance Program (DOE WAP) anticipated allocation of \$66,380 from the State of California, Department of Community Services and Development (CSD), and authorizes:

1. The Chair of the Board or designee to sign the 2013 DOE WAP Agreement between CSD and Community Action Partnership of Riverside County (CAP Riverside), not to exceed \$66,380, for the term September 30, 2013 through June 30, 2014.
2. The Riverside County Purchasing Agent to sign ministerial amendments made under the 2013 DOE WAP Agreement, not to exceed the authorized amount of \$66,380; and
3. The Executive Director of Community Action Partnership of Riverside County to administer the program and sign all certifications, assurances, exhibits, and reports made under the 2013 DOE WAP Agreement.
