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#### **BACKGROUND:**

### Summary (continued)

Exhibit "C" gives each partner city the option to transfer title of fire engines to the County. The City of Indio is requesting to transfer the title of four (4) fire engines to the County under this section of the Agreement. This Exhibit allows for the integrated operational system the flexibility in our Fire Engine assignments and it is a benefit to this system to allow our city partners to transfer titles to the County.

Once the transfer is complete, these fire engines will be listed on the City of Moreno Valley's Cooperative Agreement as part of Exhibit "C" and the city will be responsible for the annual cost of the Fire Engine Use service of \$19,200 per engine. Per the Exhibit "C", the County will be responsible for the replacement of these fire engines when the Fire Department determines the fire engines are due for replacement.
