BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) has agreed to reimburse the Sheriff's Department \$34,650 of the cost incurred for five presentations of a supervisory course to California law enforcement personnel at the Ben Clark Public Safety Training Center in FY 2013-14.

BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

The cost for the five presentations is estimated to total 80,500. After accounting for the POST reimbursement, the net County cost is \$45,850. County Counsel has approved the Agreement as to form.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

These law enforcement courses cover topics vital to the sworn first-line supervisors. Course topics include Values, Principles & Ethics; Leadership Styles & Assertive Leadership; Employee Performance Appraisal; and Counseling/Discipline. The cost for the classes is partially reimbursed by POST. Local presentation of the classes at the training center saves the County for student travel and possible lodging expenses.

EXHIBIT A (Standard Agreement)

The 80-hour mandated Supervisory Course (Regulation 1005) must be completed within 12 months of promotion or appointment to a first-level supervisory position.

SCOPE OF WORK

The Riverside County Sheriff's Department (Contractor) agrees to provide for the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST), five (5) presentations of the POST Supervisory Course to California law enforcement personnel.

- 1. Contractor agrees to place on all course announcements and informational materials the following:
 - A) "All prospective students must have completed the POST Basic Course or its equivalent prior to enrollment in the Supervisory Course."
 - B) "The Supervisory Course is specifically designed for sworn first-level supervisors and may not be compatible with the needs of students who are other than sworn first line supervisors."
- 2. The Supervisory Course is organized under the following topics:
 - Introduction-Role Identification
 - Values, Principles, Ethics
 - Leadership Styles
 - Liability Issues
 - Assertive Leadership
 - Employee Performance Appraisal
 - Counseling
 - Discipline
 - Employee Relations

- Planning and Organizing
- Communication
- Training
- Report Review
- Investigations
- Stress
- The Transition
- 3. Each course presentation shall be certified by POST and presented in accordance with content provided by POST.
- 4. Contractor agrees that they will not charge any prospective students of the Course any tuition or fees for costs associated with presentation of the curriculum except as noted below.
 - A) Fees associated with college registration, units, and related activities; or materials fees allowed by State law.

EXHIBIT B (Standard Agreement)

BUDGET DETAIL AND PAYMENT PROVISIONS

1. Invoicing and Payment

A. The total amount POST may pay the Contractor under this Agreement for services satisfactorily rendered, and upon receipt and approval of the invoices, shall not exceed the Contract Amount of \$34,650.00 as set forth in this Exhibit.

For services satisfactorily rendered, and upon receipt and approval of the invoices, the State agrees to compensate the Contractor at the end of each course, a per course rate, not to exceed \$6,930.00;

Estimated number of courses to be presented = $5 \times \$6,930.00 = \$34,650.00$)

- B. Upon completion of each presentation, Contractor agrees to submit the following before payment will be authorized:
 - Agreement Number
 - Course Title
 - Course Roster (POST form 2-111)
 - Dates of Course presented

Invoices shall be submitted in triplicate not more frequently than monthly in arrears to:

2. Budget Contingency Clause

- A. It is mutually agreed that if the Budget Act of the current year and/or any subsequent years covered under this Agreement does not appropriate sufficient funds for the program, this Agreement shall be of no further force and effect. In this event, the State shall have no liability to pay any funds whatsoever to Contractor or to furnish any other considerations under this Agreement and Contractor shall not be obligated to perform any provisions of this Agreement.
- B. If funding for any fiscal year is reduced or deleted by the Budget Act for purposes of this program, the State shall have the option to either cancel this Agreement with no liability occurring to the State, or offer an agreement amendment to Contractor to reflect the reduced amount.

3. Prompt Payment Clause

Payment will be made in accordance with, and within the time specified in, Government Code Chapter 4.5, commencing with Section 927.

EXHIBIT D (Standard Agreement)

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Settlement of Disputes

Except as otherwise provided in this agreement, any dispute concerning a question of fact arising under this agreement which is not disposed of by compromise shall be decided by POST, who shall reduce its decision in writing and mail or otherwise furnish a copy thereof to Contractor. Contractor has fifteen (15) calendar days after receipt of such a decision to submit a written protest to POST specifying in detail in what particulars the agreement requirements were exceeded. Failure to submit such a protest within the period specified shall constitute a waiver of any and all right to adjustment in agreement terms and POST's decision shall be final and conclusive. Pending final decision of a dispute hereunder, Contractor shall proceed diligently with the performance of this agreement, upon receipt of written order from POST to do so.

2. Amendments

This agreement may be amended for time, scope or increase/decrease of funds, by mutual written consent.

3. Cancellation Clause

POST reserves the right to cancel this agreement subject to 30 days written notice to Contractor.

4. Contractor Evaluation (if applicable)

In accordance with provisions of the State Administrative Manual, Section 1283, Contractor's performance under this agreement will be evaluated. The evaluation will be prepared by POST within 30 days after completion of the agreement.

5. Subcontracting (if applicable)

Contractor is expected to perform the work contemplated with the resources available within its own organization. Subcontracting of work pertinent to this Agreement shall be upon prior written consent by POST and subject to the permissive conditions set forth in the State Contracting Manual Section 3.06.

Based on "reasonable effort" to the best of its ability, Contractor warrants, represents and agrees that it and its subcontractors, employees and representative shall at all times comply with all applicable State contracting laws, codes, rules and regulations in the performance of this Agreement.

Contractor shall notify POST immediately upon termination of any such subcontract(s).
