**BACKGROUND:**

El Sol Educational Center partnered with Culturas Music and Arts on the Synergy Music & Art Fest, a community event that featured the introduction of a mural in the City of Coachella.

HARC Inc. produces/provides 1) a triennial community health assessment and report, 2) survey and data-based services, and 3) educational programs for community health organizations. The triennial health assessment provides critical health data about eastern Riverside County.

The 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Palm Springs Festival of Lights Parade will take place on Saturday December 7<sup>th</sup>. Over 90,000 people are expected to attend this year's holiday event.

Smiles for Seniors Foundation serves low income seniors who are in need of emergency financial assistance to pay for food, housing, utility payments, prescriptions and medical equipment.

The Galilee Center will be providing food during the holidays to low income families the live in the unincorporated communities in the eastern Coachella Valley.
