

BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated September 24, 2013 (Agenda Item 3-55), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Estelle Street Resurfacing Project (between McKinley Street and Grant Street) and the Grant Street Sidewalk Project (between Indiana Avenue and Magnolia Avenue) in the community of Home Gardens.

During the advertisement period, two addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders are required to acknowledge and take into account all issued addenda on their Contractor's Proposal in order to be considered for award. The addenda were issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addenda are attached as Addendum No. 1 and Addendum No. 2.

Four bids were received on October 23, 2013, ranging from \$838,000 to \$1,284,511. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Hardy & Harper, Inc. in the amount of \$838,000, which is \$32,258 (3.7%) less than the Engineer's Estimate.

The bid documents include the following schedules of work:

Base Bid 1: Estelle Street Resurfacing items of work

Alternate 1: Home Gardens Sanitary District (HGSD) manhole adjustment work for Estelle Street Resurfacing work

Base Bid 2: Grant Street Sidewalk items of work

The Alternate 1 Bid Schedule is recommended for award. HGSD concurs with bid prices for the Alternate 1 Bid Schedule as bid by Hardy & Harper, Inc., and the costs for the work will be funded by the HGSD. The Contract includes the two Base Bids and Alternate 1 Bid schedules of work.

The construction duration set for this project is for 40 calendar days, and construction is anticipated to be completed by February 2014.

The contractor is qualified to perform the work outlined in the bid. The contractor will execute the Contract and provide bonds and insurance documents after Board of Supervisor award approval.

Project No. C3-0049, Grant Street Sidewalk Construction

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Roadway rehabilitation on Estelle Street is needed due to deteriorated pavement conditions resulting from heavy wheel loads and high truck traffic volumes from adjacent industrial warehouses. The road improvements include removing a layer of existing pavement and placing new Asphalt Concrete pavement.

Grant Street improvements include the construction of approximately 780 linear feet of sidewalk on the west side of Grant Street and 163 linear feet on the east to provide a safer pedestrian path for travel to and from the Home Gardens Elementary School. All existing access ramps that do not meet the current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements will be improved or replaced to meet the new requirements. Several new access ramps will also be added.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The Contract is recommended to be awarded to Hardy & Harper, Inc. for the total amount of \$838,000.

The Grant Street improvements are partially funded with SB 821 Program through State Local Transportation Funds made available for use on bicycle and pedestrian facilities. The remainder will be funded by Measure A/Western funds.

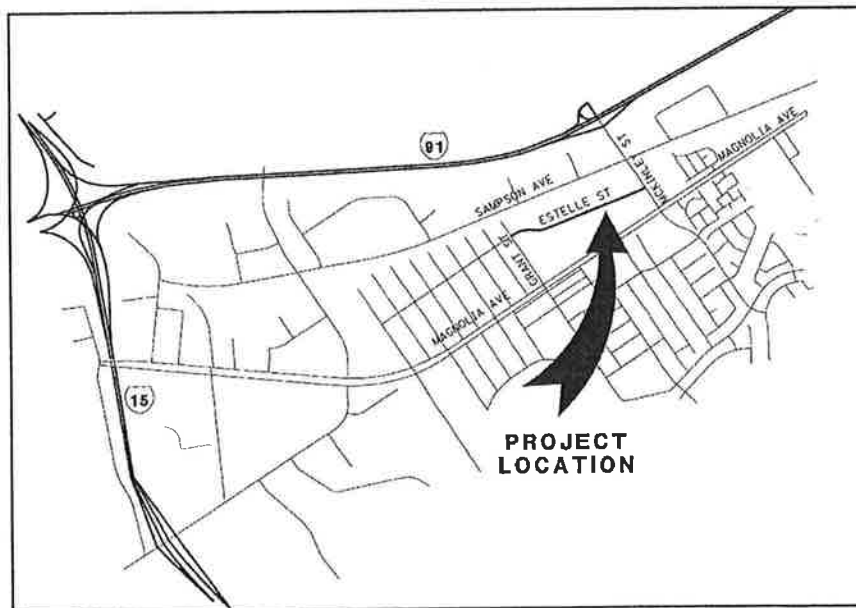
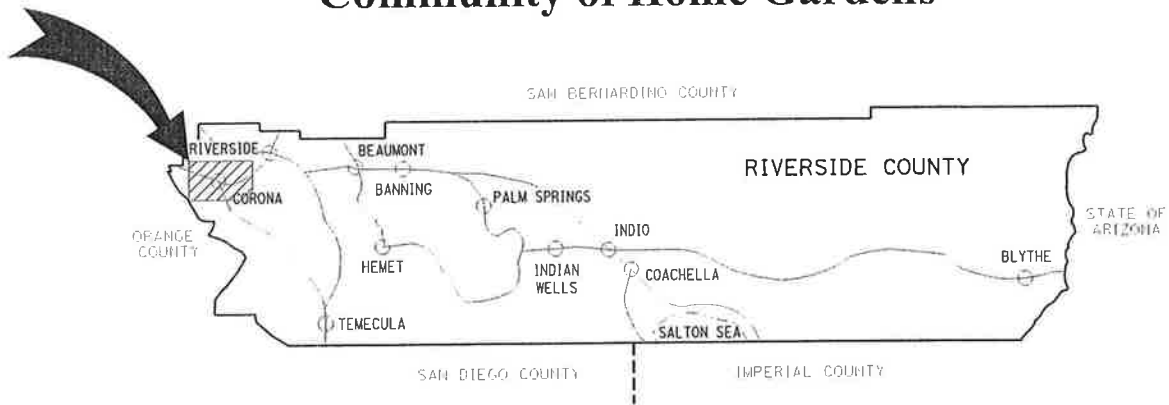
The Estelle Street improvements are funded with Gas Tax funds.

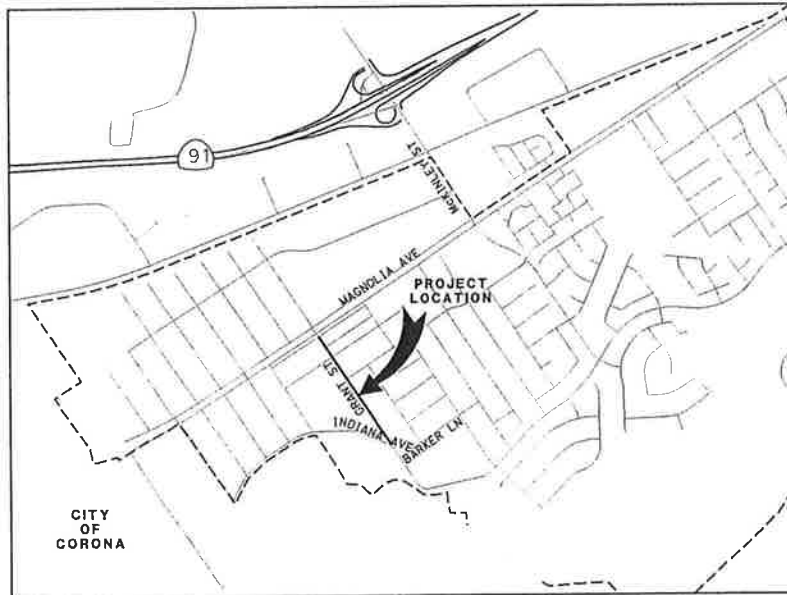
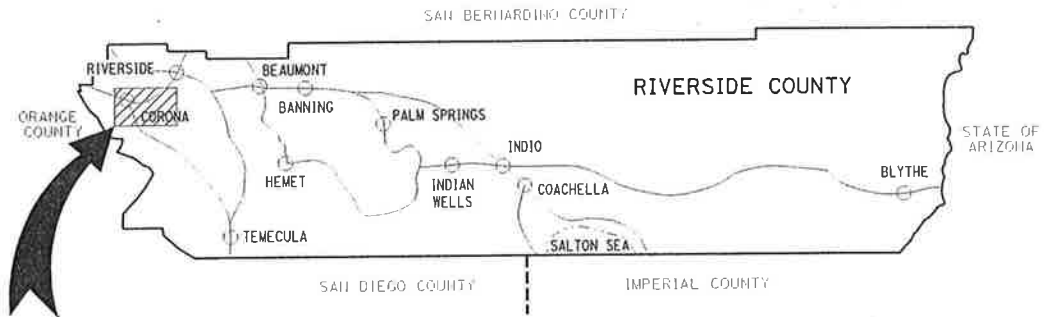


VICINITY MAP

THIS CONTRACT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and **Hardy & Harper, Inc.**, hereafter called "Contractor".

WITNESSETH

Recitals:

Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, **Estelle Street Resurfacing Project, Between Grant Street and McKinley Street, Project No. B3-0492, and Grant Street Sidewalk Project, Project No. C3-0049, Community of Home Gardens**, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.

1. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

Agreement:

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice Inviting Bids, (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of May 2006 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (l) The Plans, (m) Addenda **(one and two)**, (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Work, (o) Any Change Orders issued, (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Contract and the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

2. The Work

Contractor shall do all tasks necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Liquidated Damages and Time of Completion

Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.06, "Time of Completion", and in Section 8-1.07 "Liquidated Damages", of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

Standard Specification Section 8-1.03, "Beginning of Work" is modified to read as follows:

The Contractor shall begin work within five (5) calendar days, or as revised in the Special Provisions, of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of the Contractor's intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. If the project has more than one (1) location of work, Contractor shall submit a separate notice for each location. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation

Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.
