RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

With regard to the annexation of Zone 185 to Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated, conduct the public hearing and, after closing the public hearing, direct the Director of Transportation, or his designee, who the Board of Supervisors finds to be an impartial person as that term is used in Section 53753(e) of the Government Code, to tally all ballots received prior to the close of the public hearing. BACKGROUND:

Summary

Pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 and Resolution 2013-241 adopted October 22, 2013, the Board of Supervisors noticed a public hearing for December 10, 2013, to receive testimony regarding the Annexation of Zone 185 to Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated (L&LMD No. 89-1-C). Annexation of Zone 185 will fund the maintenance and servicing of fossil filters within public rights-of-way located northerly of Rancho California Road in the Rancho California area and includes one (1) commercial parcel.

On October 23, 2013, a notice of the public hearing and information sheet, a mail-in ballot, an impartial analysis, and a copy of Resolution No. 2013-241 was mailed to all property owners within Zone 185, proposed for annexation to L&LMD No. 89-1-C. Pursuant to the notice, all ballots must be returned prior to the conclusion of the public hearing.

Notice of the public hearing was also given by publication of a certified copy of Resolution No. 2013-241 in an appropriate newspaper at least ten (10) days prior to the public hearing date and by posting a certified copy of the Resolution No. 2013-241 on the official bulletin board customarily used by the Board of Supervisors for the posting of notices and in two (2) other public locations within the County.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The property owners within the proposed boundaries of Zone 185 have petitioned the County of Riverside to annex their property to L&LMD No. 89-1-C and understand that this annexation will result in an assessment on their property to fund the maintenance and servicing of the aforementioned improvements (fossil filters).

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The proposed budget for fiscal year 2014-15 for Zone 185 is \$636.00. This will result in an assessment for fiscal year 2014-15 within Zone 185 of \$636.00 per parcel. The annual assessment may be adjusted annually by the greater of 2% or the cumulative percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers (CPI-U), if any, as it stands as of March of each year over the base index for March of 2014.

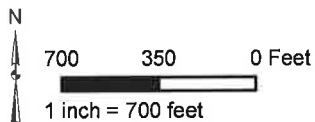
PORTION OF SECTION 26 & 27, T.7S., R.2W.

1 PARCEL

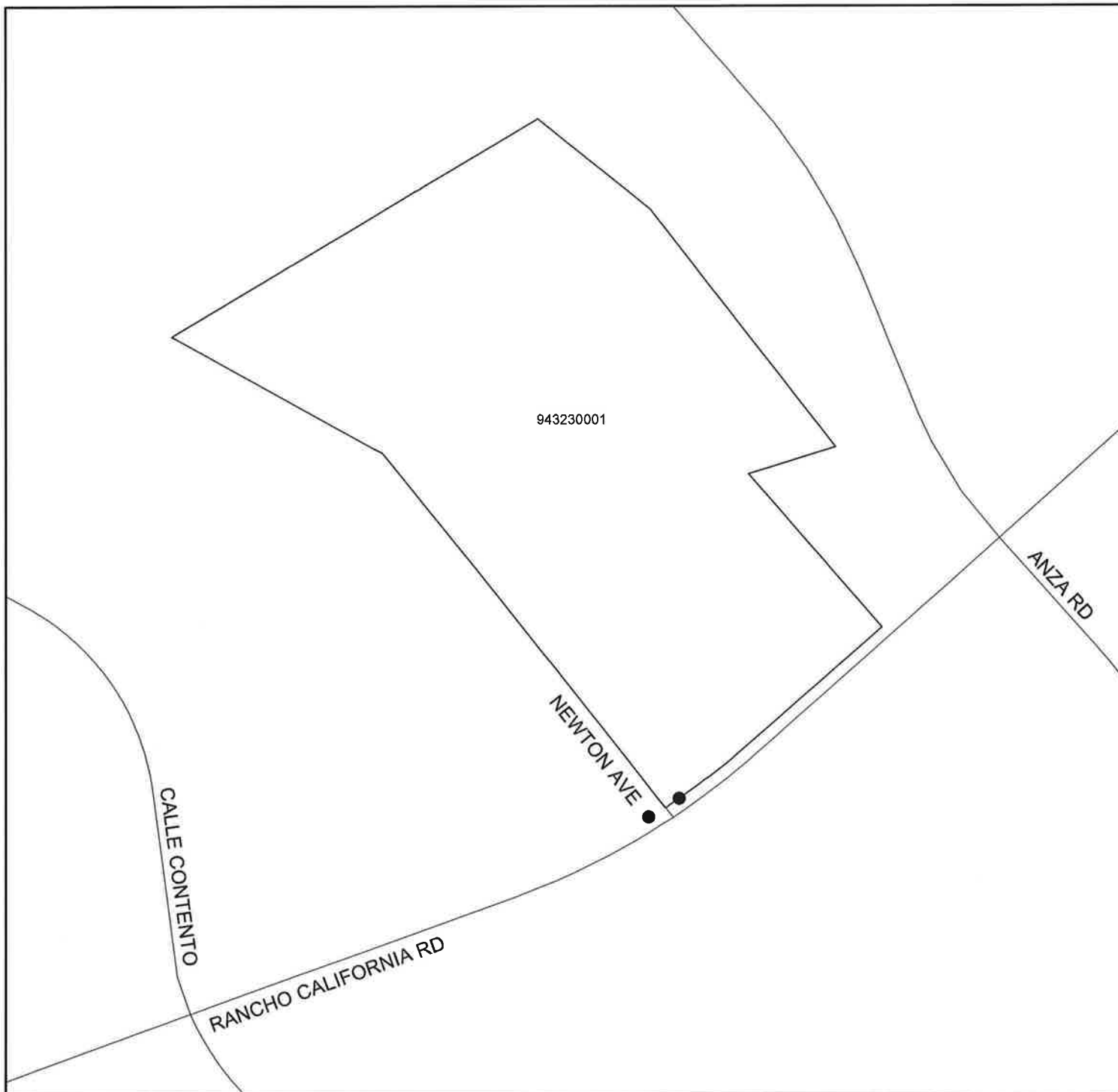


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ASSESSMENT DIAGRAM
