BACKGROUND:

Jordan Outreach Ministries operates the Kids Klub after school program for children ages 5-18 primarily residing in the cities of Indio, Coachella, Thermal, Mecca, Oasis and North Shore. . The program offers a variety of enriching activities, including: Study Klub, sports, computer center activities and learning, arts, and crafts, and other age appropriate activities.

The 20th Annual Steve Chase Awards gala will be held at the Palm Springs Convention Center on February 8th. This event benefits the Desert Aids Project client services that include: Primary and HIV-specialty care, preventive care and advocacy services.

The CVAG Homeless Committee will be authorizing the purchase of bus passes from the SunLine Transit Agency for the benefit of local homelessness service providers. Clients will be able to utilize the Sun Bus to access supportive services and seek employment so that they can become self-sufficient.

The Coachella Valley Historical Society will be providing an afterschool program for students in grades 3rd to 5th. The program will immerse children in the social studies curriculum while providing hands-on lessons, and an afternoon of creative activities and games in a safe learning environment.

The Dr. Reynaldo J. Carreon M.D. Foundation will be hosting the 2014 Student Awards Banquet on May 9th. The event benefits student scholarships.

The Joslyn Senior Center will be hosting the 5th Annual Runway event benefitting senior services on March 26 at the Agua Caliente Casino & Spa in Rancho Mirage.
