SUBJECT: Acceptance of the FY 2013/14 Life and Annuity Consumer Protection Program Grant and Adoption of Resolution No. 2014-027. All Districts [\$10,000]

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify and approve acceptance of a grant award (Grant Agreement attached) from the Insurance Commissioner of the State of California, Department of Insurance (DOI) Life and Annuity Consumer Protection Program ("LACPP") in the amount of \$10,000 for the award period July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014.
- 2) Adopt Resolution No. 2014-027 authorizing the District Attorney and/or his designee to sign the Grant Agreement on behalf of the Board.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The increasing senior population of Riverside County creates a venue for criminal activity. The vast majority of elder abuse crimes are perpetrated to separate the senior from his or her assets. To combat this growing trend of financial crimes against seniors, the District Attorney's Office re-applied for continuation of funding from the Department of Insurance, Life and Annuity Consumer Protection Program and was awarded the grant in the amount of \$10,000.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Life and Annuity Consumer Protection Program grant, made pursuant to the provisions of section 10127.17 of the California Insurance Code, will be used by the District Attorney for the enhanced investigation and prosecution of life and annuity financial abuse cases. The District Attorney's Office will also conduct education seminars targeting the senior population in the county. These seminars will reveal types of scams being used to defraud the seniors and what to do if contacted by a suspected con artist. The District Attorney's Office will also work with DOI staff.

The DA's office budgeted revenue for this category based on an estimated award amount, as a result a budget adjustment is not necessary.

The attached grant agreement and resolution have been reviewed and approved as to form by County Counsel.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

All costs under this program will be recovered through grant funding.

12 BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside,
13 State of California, in regular session assembled on _____, 2014, that the District
14 Attorney of the County of Riverside, State of California and/or his designee is authorized, on its behalf, to
15 submit and to sign the Grant Agreement, as well as related contracts, amendments, or extensions with the
16 State of California Department of Insurance that do not significantly change the grant or the contract.

17 IT IS AGREED that any liability arising out of the performance of this contract, including civil
18 court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency.
19 The State of California and DOI disclaim responsibility of any such liability.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the resolution shall be in effect for a three-year period
21 beginning July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2016.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant
23 local expenditures controlled by this body.



Duration of Grant: The grant award is for the program period, **July 1, 2013** through **June 30, 2014**.


