BACKGROUND: Summary)

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires that all substantial amendments to the County's Five-Year Consolidated Plan and the One-Year Action Plan are subject to the citizen participation process and are approved by the Board of Supervisors and HUD in accordance with the County of Riverside Citizen Participation Plan for the 2019-2014 Five Year Consolidated Plan (Citizen Participation Plan).
