### BACKGROUND: Summary (continued)

Government Code Section 82011 identifies the Board of Supervisors for the County of Riverside as the code reviewing body for a local government agency within its county. A local government agency, as defined by Government Code Section 82041, includes the Riverside County Habitat Conservation Agency.

Riverside County Habitat Conservation Agency recently revised the appendix to its Conflict of Interest Code and has submitted it for approval by the Board of Supervisors as the code reviewing body.

This office has reviewed the revised appendix and has found that it complies with statutory requirements. It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve Riverside County Habitat Conservation Agency's Conflict of Interest Code as revised (appendix) and that the Clerk of the Board notify the Agency of the action taken.

Consultants shall be included in the list of Designated Employees and shall disclose pursuant to the broadest disclosure category in this Code subject to the following limitation:

The Executive Director may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a "designated position," is hired to perform a range of duties that are limited in scope and thus is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements described in this Section. Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant's duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The Executive Director's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this Conflict of Interest Code.
